DREAMS

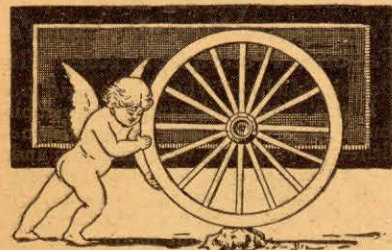

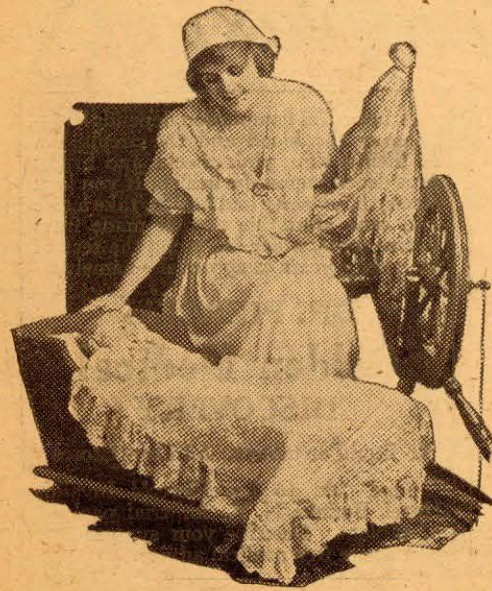

usually given on successive days, and may be repeated in three weeks. Generally a third application is given three weeks later, and these three constitute a full course. As there may be some systemic reaction, it is desirable to have the patient under observation between treatments. There is usually no confinement to bed. In the ordinary case the patient remains in the Invalids Hotel about sixty days.

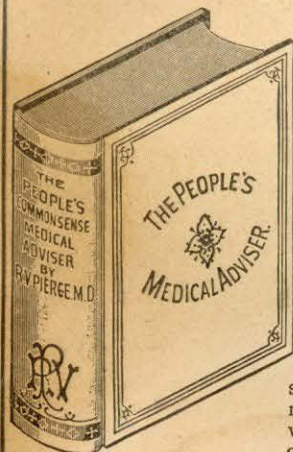
