

SOLDIER-BEAVER WATERSHED PROGRESSES

The Soldier-Beaver watershed committee met August 19th in the Schleswig Bank. Chairman, Gaylord Boeck, called the meeting to check progress on land treatment during 1971. District Conservationist, Jim Mander of Crawford District reported that approximately 5 miles of terraces had been completed with more planned. Don Kauffman, Ida District Conservationist reported that 9 miles had been completed in Ida County with more being put in.

The group reviewed the watershed to pin point damages caused by excessive water runoff.

Chairman Boeck emphasized that both county ASCS committees still have money available for cost-sharing at 70%. He urged farmers in the watershed to take advantage of the situation while they can.
