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Oklahoma Officials Examine Hardin Soil Program

Three soil conservation service engineers from Oklahoma were in Eldora recently to review the Hardin Soil Conservation District program, and in particular the grassed backslope terraces in the Pine Lake Watershed.

Examination of the local program has been recommended by state soil conservation officials. The project was shown and explained by Everett Pierce of the State Conservation Commission and Dean Miller, local Soil Conservation Technician. They were joined at a noon luncheon by Carroll Hobson of Eldora, chairman of the Hardin Soil Conservation District, and Jim Rector of Iowa Falls, FHA Supervisor.

One of the three visitors, Ken Cornforth, served as an assistant state conservationist in Iowa before being named state engineer for Oklahoma about one year ago.
