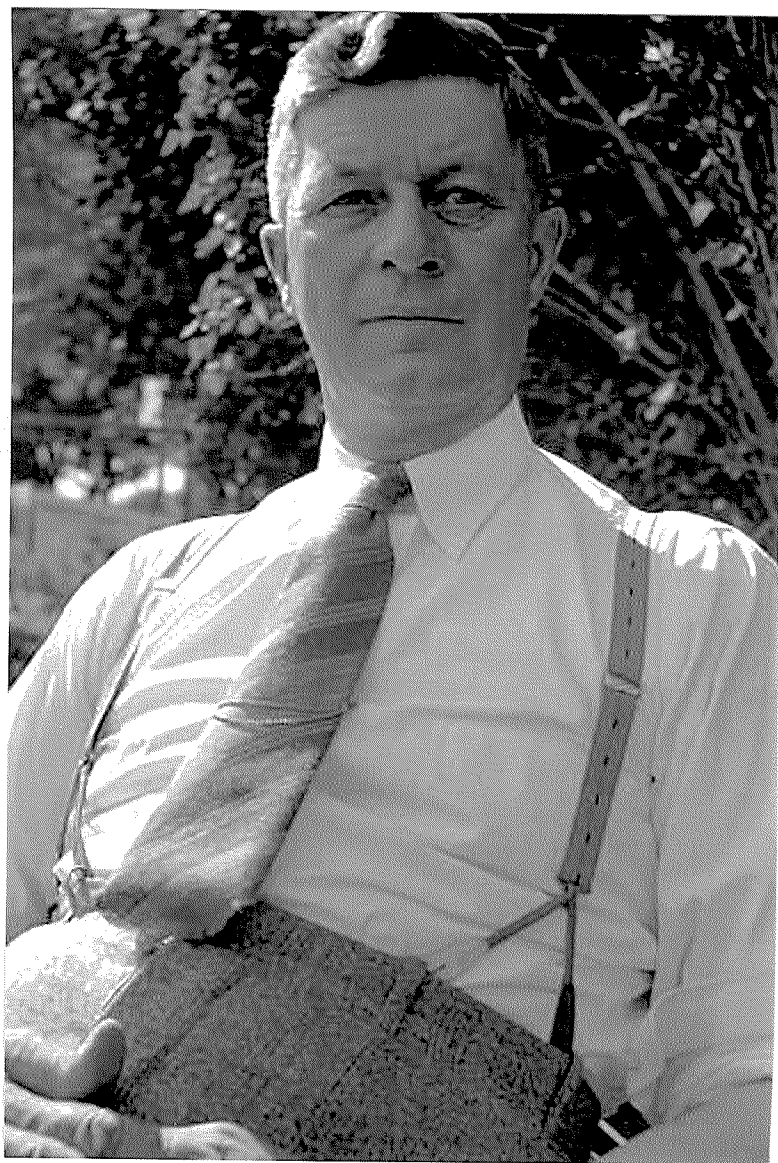

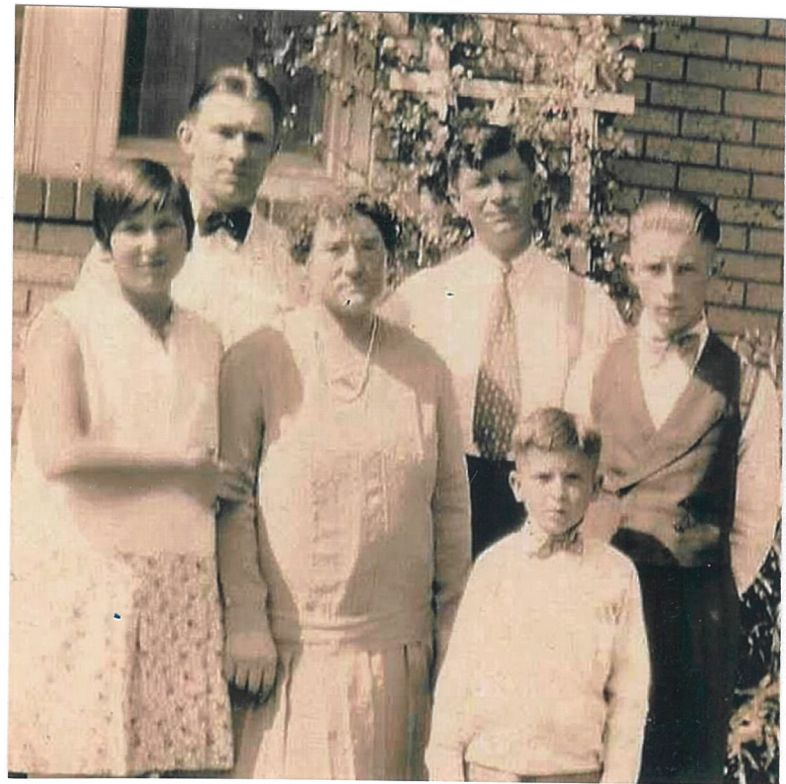

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Elmer R. Fischer

Funeral services will be held at 2 p.m. Tuesday for Elmer R. Fischer, 64, of Denver.

Mr. Fischer, son of the late county commissioner Ernest Fischer, died Thursday at his home.

He was born in Fort Collins in 1906 and was an all-state guard on the 1922 and 1923 Fort Collins High football teams. He entered business with his father and later a brother in the Ernest Fischer and sons market on West Mountain Avenue. The store ceased operation in 1952 when Fischer moved to Denver. There, he continued in the meat merchandising business until his death.

While living in Fort Collins, he was active in civic affairs, serving with the Chamber of Commerce and as president of the Kiwanis Club.

He is survived by his widow, Alice and a son, Elmer Frederick Fischer Jr. of LaJolla, Calif. A daughter, Elizabeth Ann, preceded him in death in 1953.

Other survivors include a sister, Gertrude Fischer of 135 Sylvan Court; and brothers George Fischer of 612 Elizabeth Street and James H. Fischer of 1212 Westward Drive.

Services will be conducted by the Rev. Dr. Henry Baker at the First Methodist Church. Burial will be in Grandview Cemetery under the direction of the Olinger Mortuary of Denver.

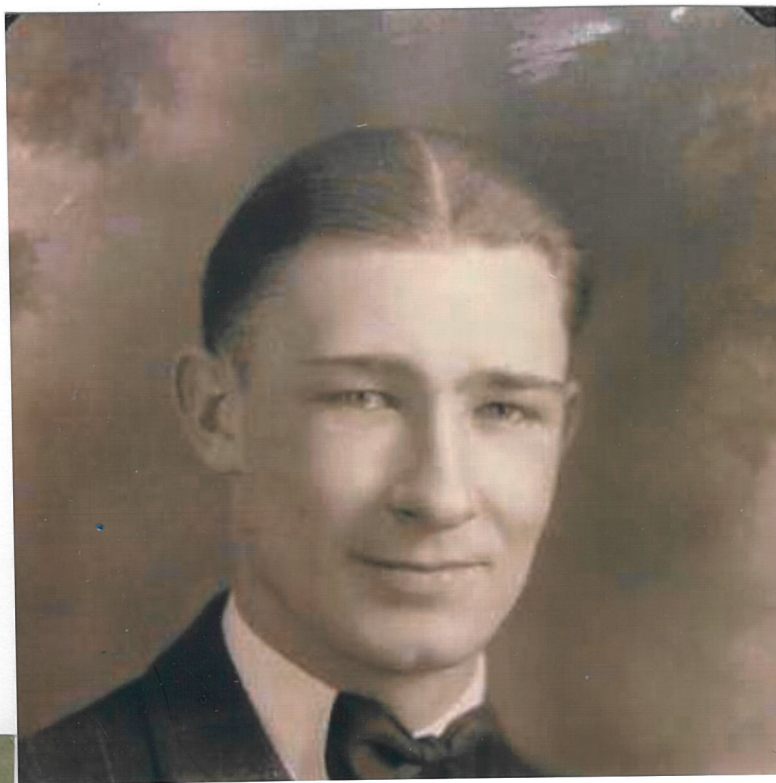

Elizabeth Fischer Winning Her Fight

"Yes, Virginia, there is a Santa Claus."

In this case clinic doctors at Rochester, Minn., appeared in the rôle of Santa Claus and 11-year-old Elizabeth Ann Fischer is the "Virginia" of the famed Christmas message, written by a newspaperman to a small girl.

Little Miss Fischer was stricken ill almost a year ago. Her condition never improved, despite attention she received from local doctors and some of the state's best specialists. Finally, just a short time before Christmas, her parents, Mr. and Mrs. Elmer Fischer of 720 West Oak street, took her to the Mayo clinic at Rochester.

Getting Better

Christmas came, and the little sufferer looked to the doctors who were attending her, hoping they would be her Santa Claus. She wanted, as do all children her age, to be healthy, to be able to play out-of-door games.

It appeared Friday that little Miss Fischer's Christmas wishes would come true. Her parents informed her grandparents, Mr. and Mrs. Ernest Fischer of 319 South Grant street, that their daughter's condition has shown improvement daily for the last 10 days. They will bring her home in a short time, if the girl continues to show improvement.

Elizabeth Fischer Loses Long Fight

Washington school classmates were saddened on Wednesday when they learned that little 11-year-old Elizabeth Ann Fischer's gallant fight against heavy odds had been lost. She died in Rochester, Minn., at 4 a. m. Wednesday.

The struggle of the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Elmer Fischer of 720 West Oak street against an illness which baffled some of the leading physicians and specialists of Fort Collins, Denver, and at the Mayo clinic in Rochester brought praise from each of the medical men who were consulted on the case. She was a brave little patient, they said.

Stricken Last April

It was probably the small girl's determination that she would recover from the mysterious malady which resulted in the sharp improvement noted in her condition Jan. 1. She was able to be up in a wheel chair at intervals during a two-week period, but a turn for the worse followed, and her condition was termed critical Feb. 1. No improvement was noted prior to her death.

She had been taken to Rochester during the week preceding Christmas in a stateroom of one of the fastest trains. Specialists of the Children's hospital in Denver had recommended her removal to the Mayo clinic.

Stricken ill in April, 1942, the child never recovered, her condition rapidly changing for the worse virtually throughout the year-long period. She had undergone an appendectomy, many blood transfusions and a number of other emergency treatments without avail. Her death occurred in St. Mary's hospital of the clinic.

Only Child

Born Nov. 12, 1931, Elizabeth Ann was Mr. and Mrs. Fischer's only child. She would have been in the sixth grade of the Washington school this year. Mr. and Mrs. Fischer are expected to arrive with her body in Cheyenne some time Thursday evening. The Blythe-Hollowell mortuary is in charge of funeral arrangements.

The child was the granddaughter of County Commissioner and Mrs. Ernest Fischer. Another grandmother, Mrs. John Spangler, lives in Denver. Other survivors are George Fischer and James Fischer of Fort Collins, Carl Spangler of Ault, and Everett Spangler of Gillett, Wyo., her uncles; Miss Gertrude Fischer of Fort Collins, Mrs. Grace Johnson and Mrs. Ralph Frank of Denver and Mrs. Christy Williams of Rolfe, Iowa, her aunts.
