ROY MEIER IS ELECTED PRESIDENT OF FIRE DEPARTMENT

Roy Meier was elected president of the State Center Volunteer Fire Department for the coming year at the annual business meeting of the organization at the City Hall Monday night. He succeeds Arthur Oehlsen. Ray Bowman was named first vice president and W. R. Koepke was chosen second vice president at the meeting. Donald Shelton was elected secretary of the department to succeed W. V. Van Pelt. George Speers was selected treasurer for the coming year.

The members present voted to present the names of Walter Eckhardt, Arthur Oehlsen, and Roy Meier for chief, first assistant chief and second assistant chief respectively to the City Council for their approval.

Services Held Wednesday For Accident Victim

Roy Meier, 59, State Center, was killed and his wife Lillith is in serious condition at Iowa Methodist Hospital, Des Moines, following a car-truck crash about 4 p.m. Sunday afternoon, Dec. 3.

Meier, who was parts manager at Weuve and Hanson International Harvester Co., State Center, was traveling north on a Story County gravel road and collided with a pickup truck driven by James D. Smith, 27, rural Colo, which was traveling west.

The intersection where the accident occurred is located four miles west and two miles south of State Center.

Smith was treated at a doctor's office in State Center and released, while Mrs. Meier was taken to Evangelical Hospital by a Nevada ambulance. She was later transferred to the Des Moines hospital.

The accident was investigated by Iowa Highway Patrolmen Bill Severin and Bill Cromer, Nevada and Jim Gustason, Story City.

No charges were filed in the accident and both the 1965 Chevrolet car and the 1964 Chevrolet truck were considered total losses.

Meier Services

Funeral services for Roy Meier, 59, were held Wednesday afternoon, Dec. 6 at 1:30 at St. Paul Lutheran Church with Rev. L. R. Meinecke offi-

ciating. Interment was in Hillside Cemetery.

Pallbearers were Earl Bernard, Ray Bowman, Floyd Honneck, Ray Wells, Fred Weuve and L. C. Hilleman.

Mr. Meier was born June 21st, 1908 at Madelia, Minn., the son of Herman and Alvina Richerdt Meier. He received his early education at Madelia before moving to State Center where he graduated from the State Center High School in 1926.

He was united in marriage to Lillith Brown on July 12, 1941 at Lancaster, Mo., and they had always made their home here since their marriage.

Mr. Meier had been employed in the implement business since 1937.

He was a 25-year member of the State Center Volunteer Fire Dept. and at the time of his passing was Assistant Fire Chief.

In addition to his wife, he is survived by one daughter, Mrs. Ervin (Judy) Walkup of State Center; two brothers, Clarence of State Center and Walter of Oklahoma City, Okla.; and four grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his parents.

Lillith Meier, 77, of State Center, died Wednesday morning, October 13 at the State Center Manor.

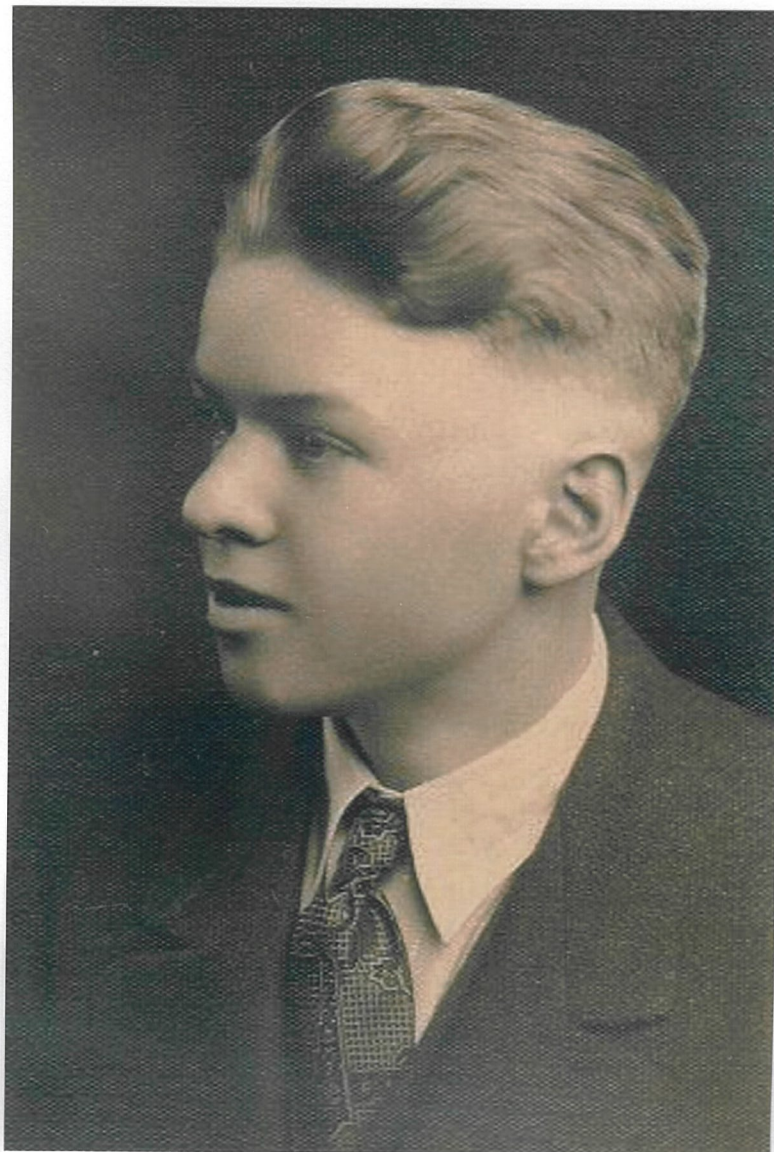
