Preston of Melbourne, became the bride of Dale F. Hilleman, son of Mr. and Mrs. Harold F. Hilleman of State Center. The Rev. Elmer J. Braun read the marriage lines for the impressive double ring service in the presence of over 200 guests. The altar was beautifully decorated with two large floor baskets of white calla lilies, yellow and white snapdragons and yellow jonquils interspersed with greenery and lighted with two seven branch candelabra in which burned tall white tapers. At the back of the altar were placed two smaller gold vases filled with yellow roses and white snapdragons. The bridal aisle was carpeted in white satin.

A 4-H farewell to Marilyn Hilleman after 30 years

Anyone who has participated in the Central Iowa Fair in the last thirty years knows what a mainstay State Center's Marilyn Hilleman has been the 4-H program. There just will be no replacing her. The position will have to take on a whole new flavor.

That familiar voice won't be heard on the fairgrounds loud-speaker announcing the next event. The smiling face with the answer to your fair question won't be behind the counter in the Fair Office. Marilyn Hilleman retired from her 12 year position as Marshall County Extension office assistant at the conclusion of the 1994 Central Iowa Fair.

Marilyn has been involved in Marshall County 4-H since she joined the Logan-Go-Get-It's Club at Van Cleve in the 1940's. As a young 4-H'er Marilyn began with projects in gardening, sewing and furniture refinishing, which soon became her favorite. Later, she worked at the State Fair 4-H Dining Hall.

After a few years break, Mari-

lyn became active as an adult leader when her own five children became 4-H members. She volunteered as a home economics leader for the State Center Cloverettes and the State Center Clever Clovers beginning in 1964.

For ten years she taught 4-H'ers to have self confidence, speak clearly, and offered specific teaching in all aspects of home economics, from clothing to food and nutrition and home improvement. She taught her girls life skills that they are still using today. Marilyn's 4-H girls honored her in 1973 when she retired as their leader.

Marilyn then became active on the county level as a member of the 4-H Youth Committee. She judged many achievement shows and assisted with county fair judging.

"After Dale died, Gene Neven called and asked me to apply for the office assistant job. I completed 11 full years," said Marilyn. "I love being around people and I love the fair. I know I will be teary when the fair comes around, but I will be

here with my grandchildren."

Through the years, Marilyn has seen lots of changes in the county fair. The history of the State Center Clever Clovers Club noted a change in 1972 when enrollment cards became computerized and all materials came directly from Iowa State University Extension. Marilyn added, "There are not as many numbers. There are too many other activities for kids to be involved in. It takes a lot of encouragement and a lot of support to keep kids in the (4-H) program with so many other choices."

"The kids and their families are my favorite thing about this job. I'm so proud of the children when they are showing or receive special awards or go to the State Fair," said Marilyn. "Some of the best moments have been when my special 4-H friends have received the Hall of Fame Awards, especially those I have worked with, like Gene Neven. I was so pleased they were honored."

Marilyn says simply, "It is time to retire. There are things I want to do. I want to be able to say to my

grandkids that I'll be there when they have a ball game or something they are involved in. I plan to just go on with my life, spending a lot more time with my coffee cup, the morning paper and *Good Morning America*." Marilyn had six grandchildren participating in the county fair this year.

So, what encouragement does this veteran 4-H person have for others who are contemplating getting involved?

"When you volunteer or work with kids, you are the one who benefits from the knowledge you gain and the life long friendships you make."

The reverse is true also, if the number of well wishers Marilyn talked to at the 1994 Central Iowa Fair is any indication. This beautiful, down to earth woman has touched endless numbers of 4-H'ers and their parents through the years.

Marilyn's expertise and genuine dedication to the Central Iowa Fair will be missed and there are acres of 4-H'ers wishing her all the best in retirement.

What's Cooking Neighbor?



A native of New York, Patty Hilleman and her two sisters came to the Midwest to spend summers with their father, who worked in Ames, and then returned to the East to live with their mother during the winter. Patty said she and her sisters were horse crazy and the possibility of owning their own horse was a great promise that was eventually fulfilled for the girls as their father matched their savings and bought a horse.

Thus coming to Iowa State University to go to school wasn't all that strange at all for Patty, and that's where she met Randy Hilleman, a State Center native. Patty graduated in 1975 in consumer services, while Randy had graduated the year before in the area of animal science. Patty worked for the Marshall County Courthouse for a few years during the Hillemans' early marriage, but when Marcy was born she stayed home to be an almost full-time homemaker and only occasionally helps out at the courthouse on a part-time basis.

Marcy is now seven years old and a second grader, while Leslee, four, attends Clemons Lutheran pre-school, and Haley, two, is the baby of the bunch. The girls take after their mother, according to Patty, especially in the area of eating, as they prove to be extremely finicky eaters. Patty said that she herself had been a bad example for the girls, who don't like vegetables and curl their noses at many dishes. She said she alternates between "you sit there until you eat every morsel" to "well, if you don't want to eat, then starve."

The Hillemans live on a farm two miles north of State Center where Randy farms raising hogs and growing corn and beans. Patty helps out on the farm, driving the tractor and participating in other tasks as well. Through the years, Patty was proprietor of the Party Room business of Main Street State Center as well as working at the court house, but the future holds no big plans for Patty for a job outside of the home. "I like to be at home," she says simply and explains that she has plenty to do with the regular housework along with her chair caning business and her many household projects. One of the latter features Patty's dehydrated fruits, as she treats apples, apricots, bananas, pineapples and other fruit in a dehydrating machine to be used for snacks that even the girls enjoy.

Patty said that the Hillemans eat simple and light during the hot summer months, and enjoy a lot of sandwiches. In the winter the main meal of the day is at night. Although the girls can be very choosy eaters, they all seem to agree on one thing: mom's own tomato sauce, which Patty makes from home-grown tomatoes and serves on a variety of dishes, from tacos to pizza. The girls also all agree that puppy chow is a favorite snack. This special treat features chex cereal, chocolate chips and peanut butter, and was featured in this newspaper earlier this year in connection with an article about Sue Robinson.

Randy, Patty says, is the easiest family member to please as he will try more foods than the ladies in the family.

The recipes Patty shares today feature a pork stew, a good pork producer recipe especially for persons who have plenty of Iowa chops in the freezer. The buttermilk pound cake is a special dessert that Patty said can be served with ice cream or peaches. Patty's tomato sauce is her specialty. This year she froze some 24 quarts of the sauce, which she uses for many recipes, such as the pizza meat, which is a favorite of the whole family. The rice crispie cookies are a simple and quick cookie recipe from the Farm Bureau Spokesman.

The Hillemans' favorite place to eat is Bailey's Pizza, a restaurant that they frequent approximately twice a month.
