

Soil Conservation Queen Contest Set For July 15

The 1965 Hardin County "Queen of Conservation Contest" will be held Thursday, July 15, at Blanche and Ethel's Tearoom in Eldora.

Deadline for entries in the contest, sponsored by the Soil Conservation Districts of Iowa and the Farmers Grain Dealers Association, Des Moines, is Friday, July 9. Entries should be sent or taken to the Hardin Soil Conservation District Office in Eldora.

The contest is open to all single girls between the ages of 16 and 21 who reside on farms in Iowa. The Queen will be chosen on her poise, personality, intelligence and personal attractiveness. She will also need to have a general knowledge of soil conservation farmer cooperatives and agriculture in general.

The two winners in the Hardin District contest will compete in a regional contest in August with the winner vying for the "State Queen of Conservation" title in September.
