During the middle of the afternoon word came in from W. C. Hilleman's that Harty Groth, the 14 year-old son of Rev. and Mrs. U. Groth, had been accidentally shot. The boy, with his brother, Hans, and Harvey Hilleman had spent the day in the fields hunting rabbits, and were on their way home, having secured all the game they

cared to. As they were proceeding along their way, walking abreast, Harty spied another rabbit and started after it. In an instant his brother had shot, the ball striking him in the left thigh and passing completely through it. The wounded boy, weak from the loss of blood, was taken to the Hilleman home, where he still is receiving every care. A medical examination showed the course of the bullet, but it was difficult to determine if the bones had been shattered.

Gets in Way of Rifle.

Saturday afternoon Hans and Hardy Groth, aged 17 and 14, sons of Rev. U. Groth, went to the home of their uncle, W. C. Hilleman to spend the day hunting. They were accompanied on their quest for rabbits by 14-year-old Harvey Hilleman. Young Hilleman saw a rabbit, and was taking aim when Hardy Groth stepped in the way. Hilleman did not notice Groth's approach, and pulled the trigger. The ball from a 22-caliber rifle, struck Groth in the fleshy part of the hip. The bone was not fractured, and unless some septic trouble results the lad should make a rapid recovery.

Oltman, pastor of St. Paul's Lutheran church, performed the ceremony in the presence of a small company of relatives and intimate friends. Rev. Oltman used the impressive ring service in reading the nuptial vows.

The bride, who was attired in a handsome gown of Nile green messaline, was attended by her sister, Miss Ildra Wengert. Leland C. Hillemann, cousin, of the groom, was best man.

During the ceremony Mrs. J. G. Oltman sang "O Promise Me," and during the congratulatory period she sang "Love Me and the World is Mine." She was assisted by Miss Irene Funke at the piano.

Harvey Hilleman, Longtime Resident Succumbs Sunday

Harvey Hilleman, more familiarly known as Pat, 64 and a life long resident of this community, passed away early Sunday at the Evangelical hospital in Marshalltown where he had been confined for about a week. His death was attributed to a heart condition and complications.

Funeral services were held Tuesday afternoon at 2 o'clock at the St. Paul Lutheran church with the Rev. Elmer J. Braun, officiating. Interment was in Rose Hill Memorial Gardens, east of Marshalltown. The Wenzel Funeral Home was in charge.

Pall Bearers were Harold Anderson, D. H. Moore, S. V. Zeager, Earl Pfantz, Oscar Wehrman and James Kratovil. Flower bearers were Dorine Lampkin, Irene Riemenschneider, Pauline McClure, Sherry Meier, Lorraine Flaming and Joan Hilleman.

Mr. Hilleman was born May 5, 1894 at State Center, the son of Fred and Mary Garbleman Hilleman. He received his education in the State Center schools.

He was united in marriage to Clara Wengert on January 27, 1916 at State Center and the couple farmed near here for seven years before moving into town.

Mr. Hilleman was employed by the State Center Farmers Co-operative Creamery for 38 years as a cream hauler. During the past year he has been employed at the local Municipal Light plant.

He was a member of St. Paul Lutheran Church, serving as treasurer for several years of that body and custodian for 25 years. He was a member of the Modern Woodmen of America, Camp 2524, of which organization he was secretary for 25 years and the State Center Volunteer Fire Department.

In addition to his widow he is survived by a daughter, Mrs. Donald Funke of Melbourne; a brother, Wilbert Hilleman of State Center; a sister, Mrs. Elda West of Fort Collins, Colo; and four grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by a son, Darwin, his parents, two sisters and a brother.
