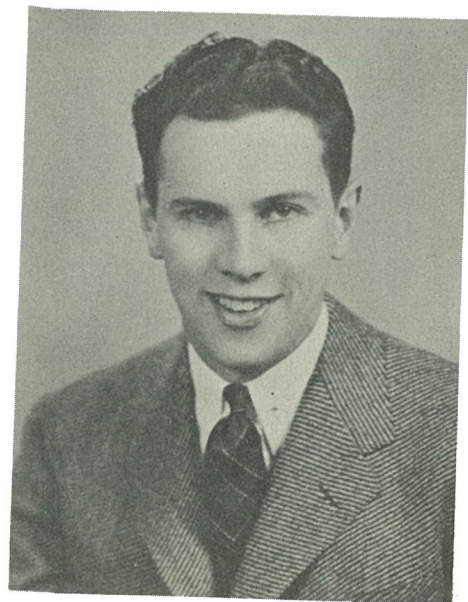
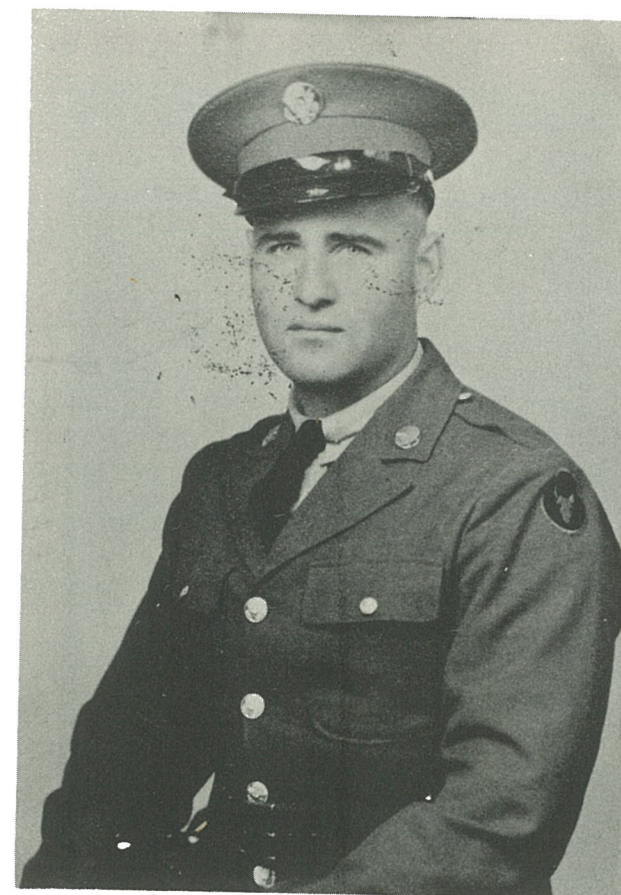




PAUL SCHARF

Enlisted in early summer 1941, at Grundy Center, Iowa. Stationed at March Field, California in Army Air Corps. Graduated May 28, 1943, at Columbus Army Flying School, Columbus, Mississippi. Transferred to West Coast, to Seattle, Washington. Sent overseas, served in European Area, as a Bomber Pilot. Shot down over Germany June 10, 1944. Reported Missing.



CLARENCE SCHULZ

Entered the Army April 17, 1941. Basic training at Camp Claiborne, Louisiana with 34th Division of Iowa National Guards. Left for overseas February 18, 1942. Stationed in Ireland, England, and Africa. Guarded General Eisenhower's Staff. Fought in Italian Campaign. Returned to U. S. September 1944. Served as Guard of German Prisoners of War at Camp Maxey, Texas. Honorably Discharged June 11, 1945, at Jefferson Barracks, Missouri.
