

Council denies reimbursement request for terrace removal

A request by the Plymouth County Soil and Water Conservation District for reimbursement of state cost share funds as a result of terrace removal was unanimously denied by the Le Mars City Council this week against the advice of city attorney Joe Flannery.

Reason for the action is that council members feel they are being asked to refund state money for something they were never made aware of by previous land owners.

Flannery advised the city to reimburse the state cost share funds and seek recovery from previous landowners due to lack of notification.

Total requested reimbursement from the city is \$923.
