

DNR Private Lands Program has Habitat Cost Share Available

The Iowa Department of Natural Resources Private Lands Program has received a grant from the National Fish and Wildlife Foundation (NFWF) that will help with native prairie restorations. The grant will pay for 75% of the cost of a prairie restoration. The landowner will pay the remaining 25% of the installation cost. Cost shared items will be: native prairie seed, seeding (drill), herbicide (where necessary) and mowing in the establishment year. Contractors must be used to establish and maintain the seeding and landowners will work with the DNR Private Lands biologist on the habitat agreement and planning process.
