

Trefoil Tour For Visitors 8/27/63

Several carloads of Missouri conservationists will be in Davis county Sept. 5 to take a Birds-foot trefoil pasture tour, according to Clay Barnett, a Davis county soil district commissioner.

The trefoil pasture, common in Iowa, is not used at all in Missouri, said Barnett, and the group from Lancaster, Mo., will be given a tour to see how well it serves as pasture.

Barnett said the tour will begin Thursday, Sept. 5, between 8:30 and 9 a.m. on his farm. Among the other farms to be visited are those of Wayne Proctor, Richard Wilty, Sam Botts, Jr., Bonnie Houston, and others in south Davis county.

The visitors will include the Scotland county, Mo., work unit conservationist and soil district commissioners from that county. Barnett invited Davis county farmers or businessmen to join the tour group.
