Enlisted January 1941, entered service February 10, 1941 with National Guards, Co. H., 34th Division at Marshalltown, Iowa. Basic training at Camp Claiborne, Louisiana, Ft. Benning, Georgia, Ft. Dix, New Jersey.

Left for overseas, landed in England; served in Ireland, Scotland, North Africa, Italy. Returned to states and stationed at Camp Robinson, Arkansas.

Honorable Discharge June 20, 1945.
