

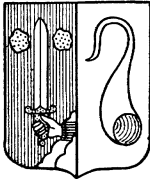

Please find enclosed a few postcards from our place, located 50 miles west of Strasbourg, on the line joining this town to Paris.

The population is composed of 55 inhabitants, all farmers. Get, since there is a lake nearby (the area of the lake amounts to about 1 900 acres), our village has become a holiday center with 330 tourist houses and 7 camping areas. In Summer, there are about 5.000 people on the parish grounds.
