

Crop production methods to be explored at upcoming conference

New crop production methods that improve farm profitability while reducing soil erosion will be explored at an upcoming conference to be held in four Midwest cities in January.

The Crop Residue Management Conference & Trade Show will feature 22 informative sessions taught by experienced farmers and agricultural experts. These sessions are designed to help farmers lower production costs while adapting tillage practices to meet conservation compliance guidelines mandated by the federal government.
