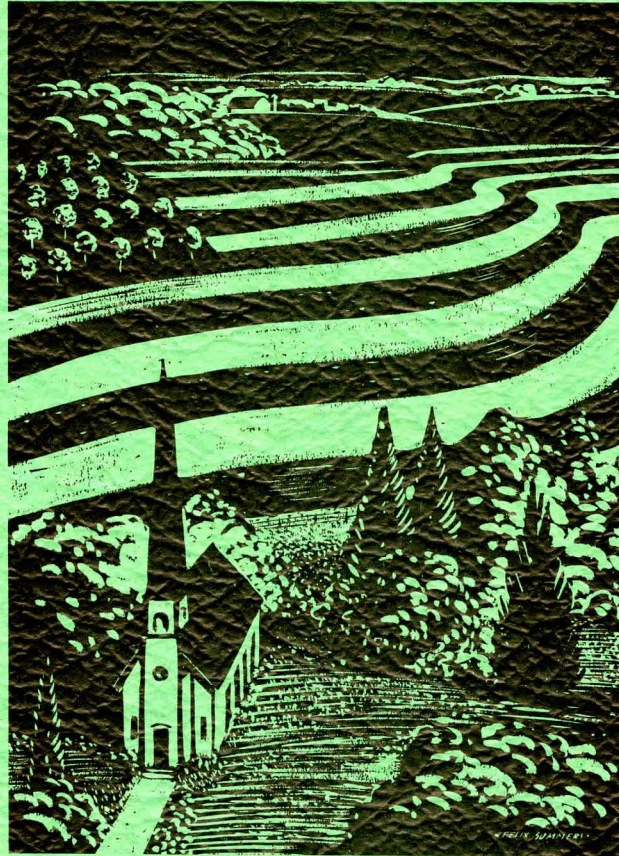

Commissioner's Comments

1941-1972 Thirty one years of progress

In 31 years there has been much progress. 19,900,617' of terraces have been built, 1,716,240' of them are parallel. 838,910' of tile installed, 2,857 acres of waterways constructed. 72 acres of trees planted.

In FY 72 10,912 acres were contoured.

The big thing last year was minimum tillage. This is comparatively new, but 2,461 acres were farmed in this manner in Mills County.

Native grass or warm season grass pastures are becoming better known in our area.

The farm owners and operators are taking an active interest in feedlot runoff pollution. Insecticides and herbicides are better controlled.

Trees have become a necessity. Not only as tree plantings and windbreaks, but as ornamental plantings in both urban and rural Mills County.

A Standard Soil Survey will be started this fall.

Sanitary Land Fills are being constructed in our county.

Progress is sometimes slow -- but we will not stand still. Each month, each season, each year our statistics show that Mills County IS on the move.

Wish we had planted forty acres of Oaks, Walnuts, Maples, Pines, etc., back in the Seventies. They would be almost thirty years old now. We could charge fifty cents a look, dollar a touch and five dollars a walk through. Boy! would the money roll in.

Conservation Talk in The Year - 2,000

Where shall we spend our vacation this summer? How about Canda? I hear they still have trees and forests. The kids have never seen a tree and I kind of miss them too! When did the last trees die in Mills County? Well, by the early Seventies almost one hundred percent of the Elms were dead. Soon Walnut, so valuable for vanner, Oak, other hard woods and even the Cottonwood fell to the saw mill. Later Austrian Pine, recommended so highly, developed problems with Red Spider Mite. People didn't have time to spray them, let alone plant a suitable replacement. This, plus dozing them out for roads, housing, and farming and PRESTO NO TREES!
