

Camp Scholarships Are Announced ^{6/7/66}

Harold Baughman, chairman of the Davis County Soil Conservation District announced today two teachers in the Davis County Community School District have been awarded tuition scholarships to attend Iowa Teachers Conservation Camp during the summer sessions.

Mrs. Hazel Boley, high school science teacher, and Mrs. Ann Ellen McMains, first grade teacher, will each attend the schooling for a three-week period where three semester hours of on-campus credit will be earned.

The major fields emphasized are Biology 104, which is the study of forest resources, ecology, and fish and wildlife management; and Biology 105, which is the study of rocks and minerals, soil and land management, as well as water conservation.

The camp is located in Springbrook State Park which is seven miles north of Guthrie Center.

The Davis Soil Conservation District each year chooses two teachers, within the Davis County Community School system, to take part in this educational program. Any interested teacher may apply for the 1967 scholarship award between now and the 1967 camp session, Baughman stated.
