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The State Soil Conservation Committee approved two Public Law 566 watershed applications at its June meeting. These include the Union Watershed located in the Hardin County Soil Conservation District and the Elk Creek Watershed located in the Monona and Harrison County Soil Conservation Districts. The Union Watershed is a small watershed which contains the Town of Union and the main problem being experienced is flooding through this town. The Elk Creek Watershed is a larger area that is experiencing a considerable problem with gully control. There are many active gullies in the area that need attention. More complete stories on these watersheds appear elsewhere in this issue.
