FOREWORD

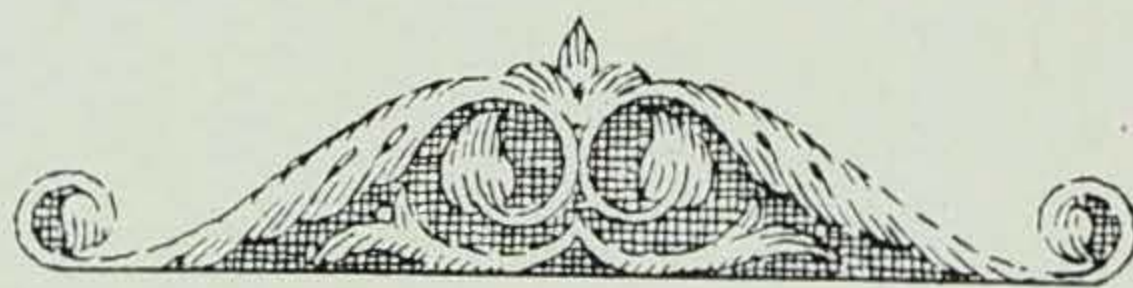
