## Cheerleaders

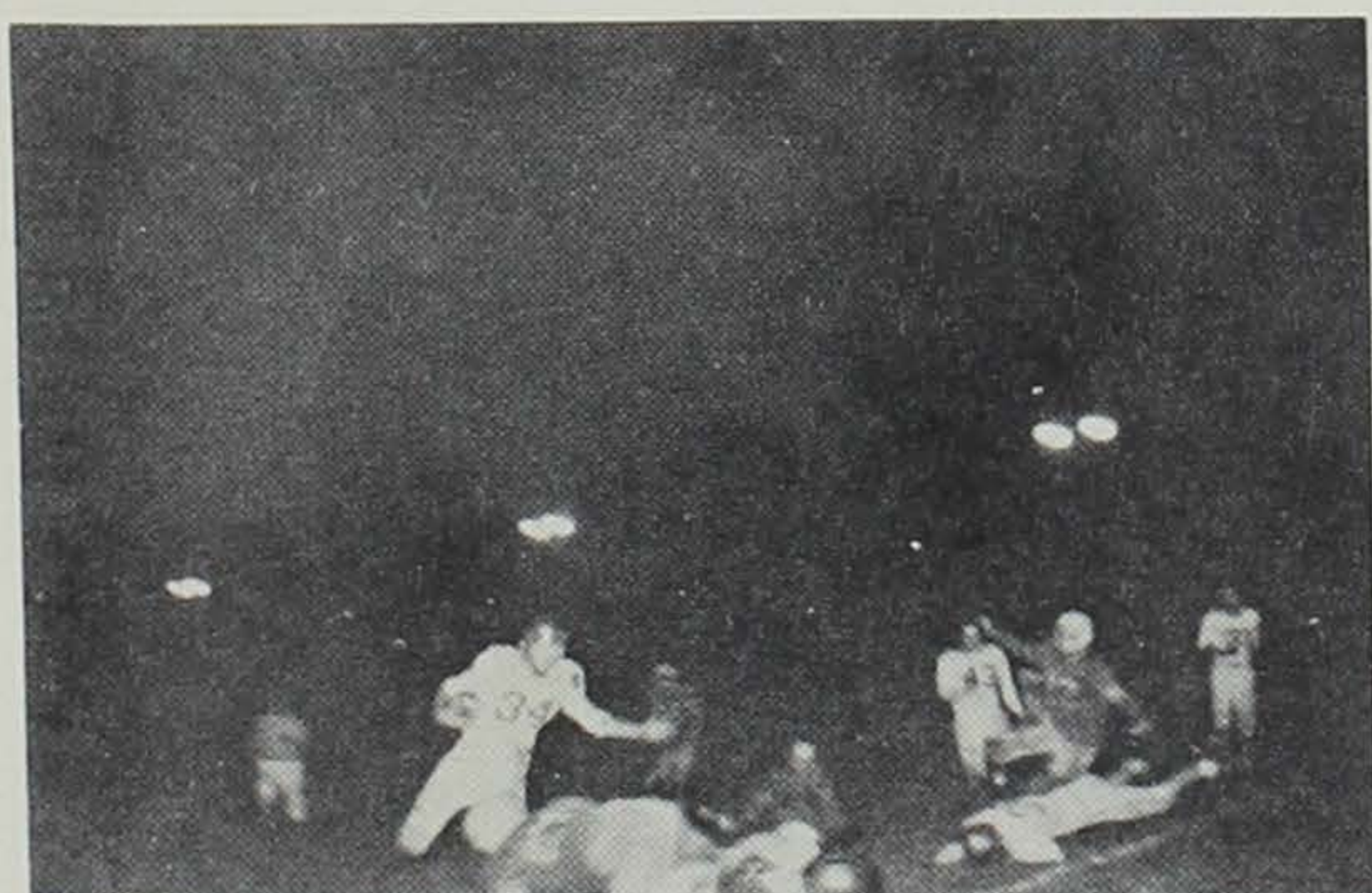

These groups and soloists have participated in several state music contests and have provided music for many school, civic, and church functions.



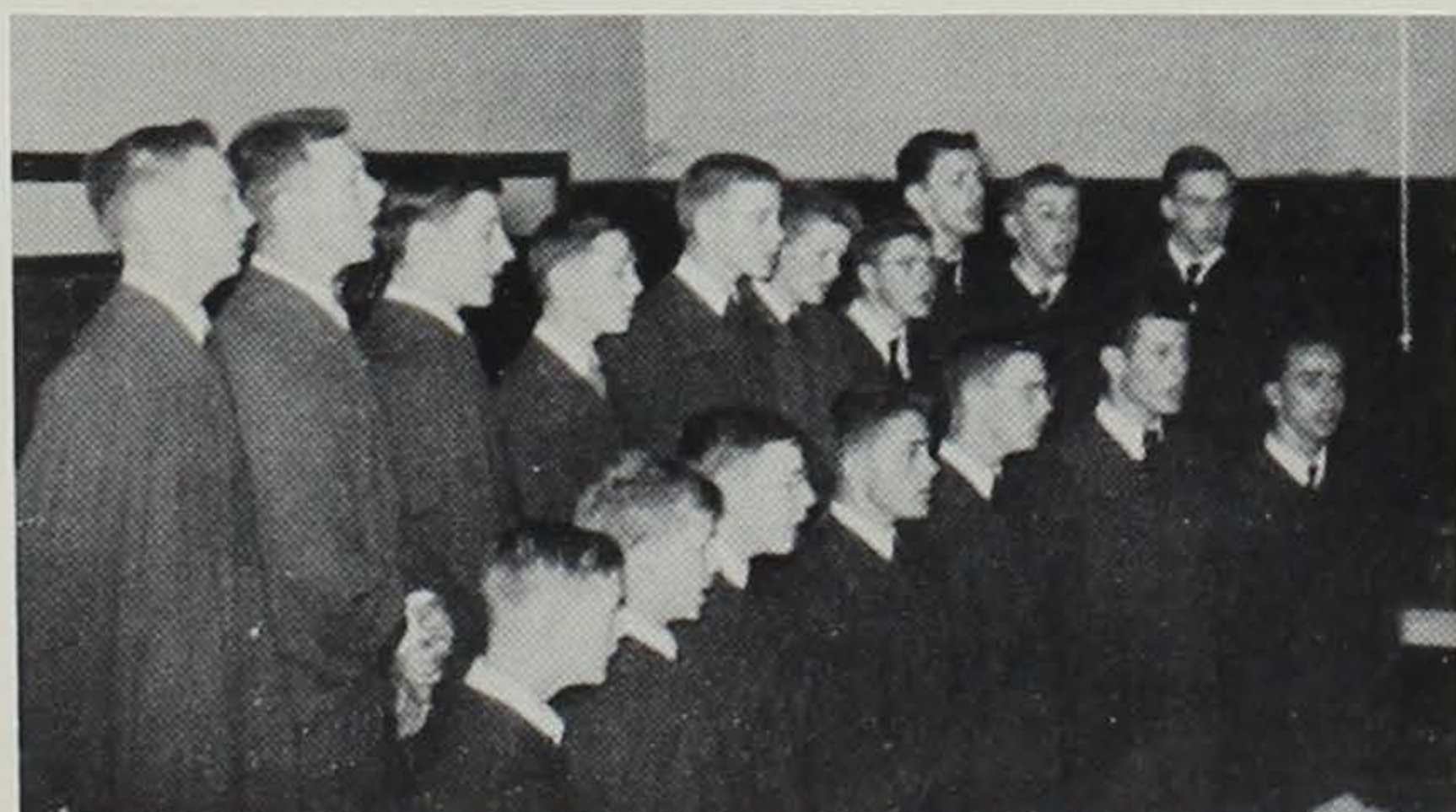

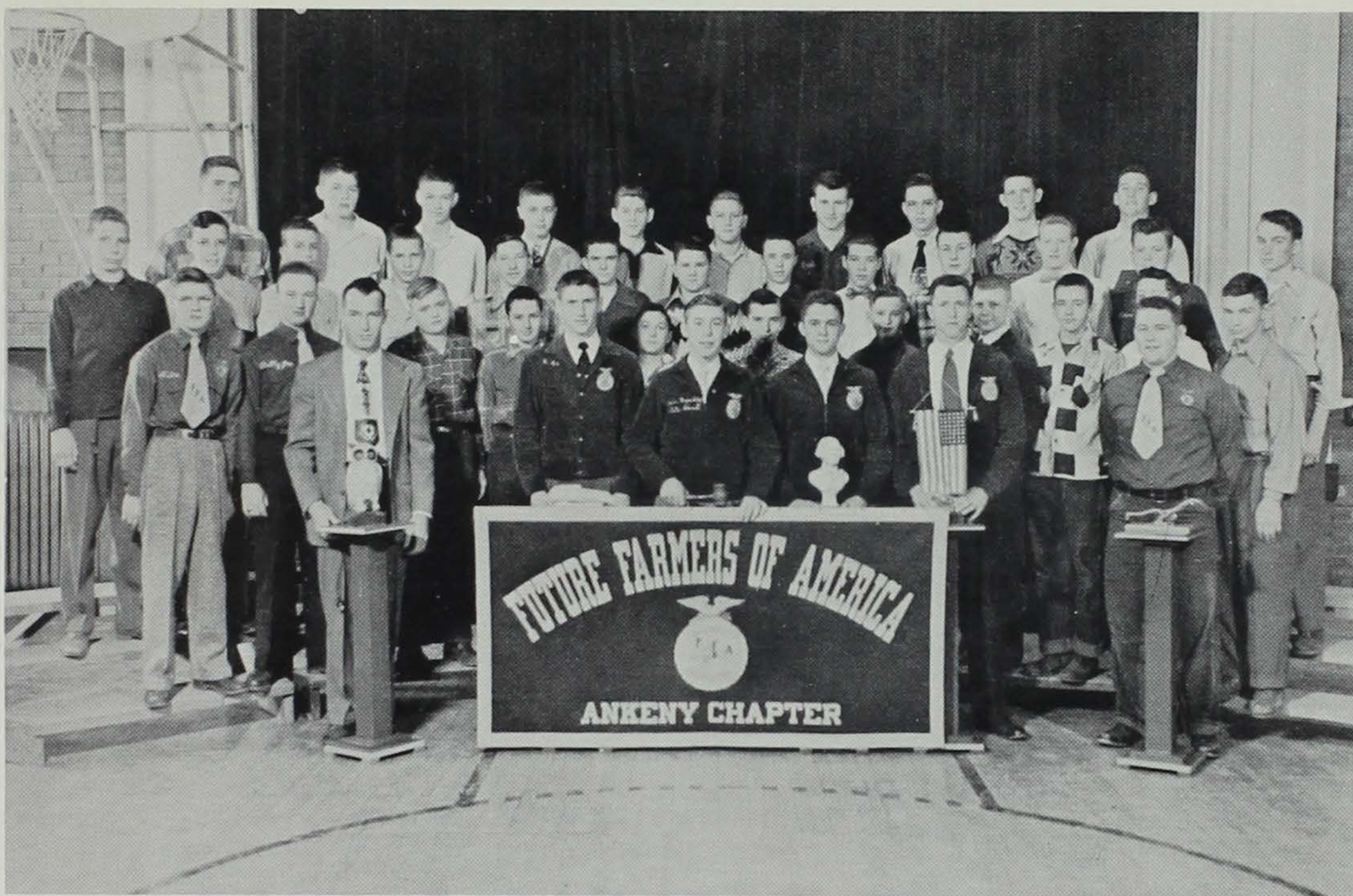
## Annual Staff
