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Duncan to Speak At Soil Meeting

E. R. Duncan, Extension Agronomist, Iowa State College will be the featured speaker at the Hardin Soil Conservation District Annual Meeting and election March 9 at the Youth Building, Eldora.

His talk will center on the role of continuous row crops and forages in a farming program, announced Dean Kelsey, Chairman of Hardin S.C.D.

Candidates for commissioner to fill the expired term of Kenneth Meier, Hubbard, are Leland Reece, New Providence, and Glen Robinson, Buckeye. The election will be held from 7:00 p.m. to 9 p.m. with the Annual Meeting starting at 7:30 p.m.
