Enlisted in Navy, July 7, 1942.
Boot training at Great Lakes Naval Training Station, then
to Electricians School at New London, Connecticut, sent
out with Submarine Squadron 3, which operated out of
Panama Canal Zone. Transferred to Mare Island, Cali-
fornia in August 1943 and assigned to Submarine Tinosa
which sank 22 enemy ships and 12 probables. He belongs
to the "Mighty Mine Dodgers" Order which has less than
300 members, all of whom came out of the Sea of Japan
after surrender.
Honorably Discharged September 30, 1945.
