According to authorities, Dennis and a friend, Dale Edward England, 19, also of Colo., were driving in a car that collided with another at the intersection of Highways 69 and 2 about a mile south of Leon, Iowa.

Miss Bridger and Mr. England were taken to the Cedar County Hospital at Leon where both were listed in fair condition.

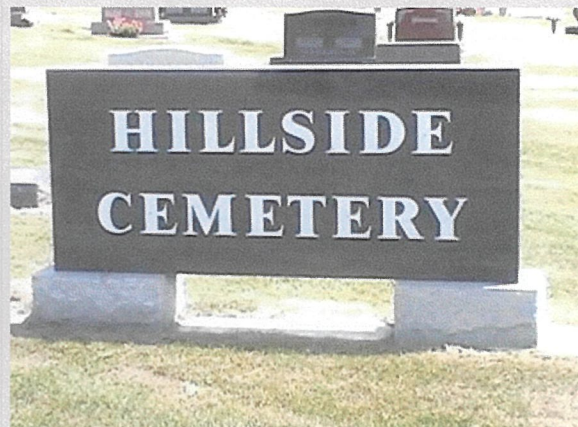

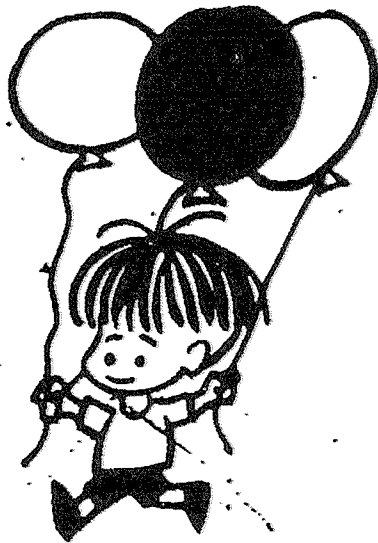

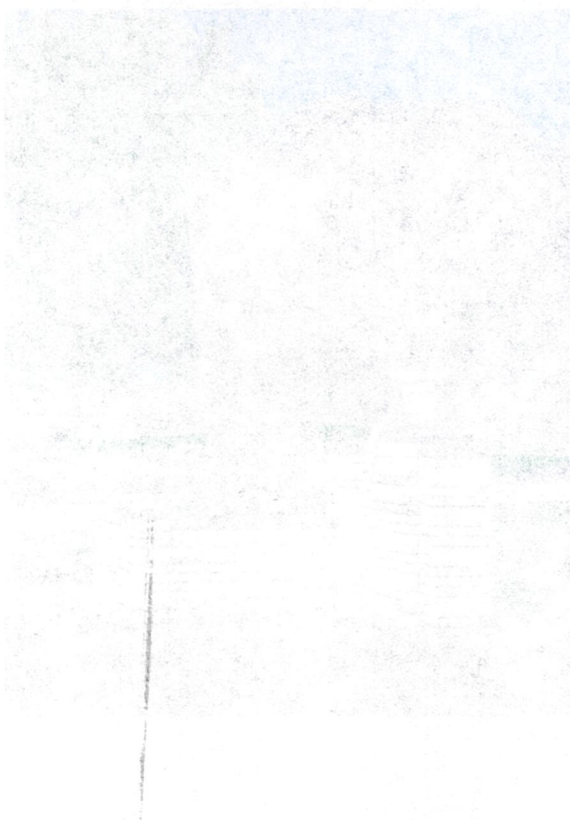
