

Taking Final Shrub Orders

Final trees and shrubs orders for farm planting are now being accepted at the Soil Conservation Service and Extension Service offices in Eldora, reports Cal Moore of the Soil Conservation Service.

Those planning to establish forest, conservation and wild-life plantings are urged to order their trees and shrubs this week. Planting assistance will be given through the Extension Service and Soil Conservation Service for demonstration purposes. Two tree planters are available in the county to aid in planting projects.

Application may also be made for cost-sharing assistance on forest tree planting and plantings made for erosion control purposes through the ASO office at Iowa Falls. Through cost-sharing 80 percent of the cost of the trees and shrubs up to \$45 per acre is eligible for assistance.

The following tree and shrub species are available: Austrian pine, red pine, white pine, multiflora rose, honeysuckle, purple willow, wild grape, silver maple, Russian olive, ninebark, green ash, dogwood, oragana, black walnut and black locust.
