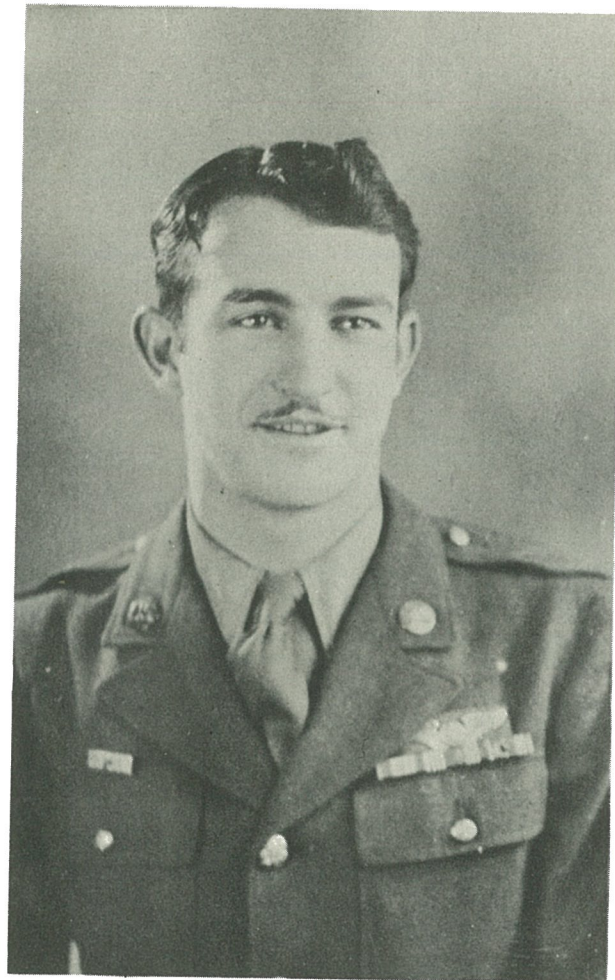
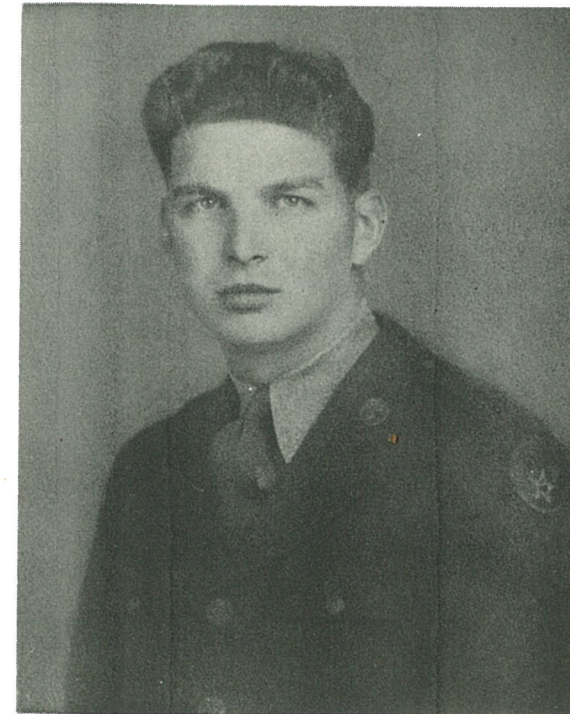




S/Sgt. RICHARD LYNCH

Inducted January 13, 1944, at Des Moines, Iowa. Entered active service February 2, 1944. Attended camps at Keesler Field, Mississippi; Aerial Gunnery School at Harlington, Texas, March Field, California. Went overseas from Huntington Field, California, November 3, 1944. Received A.T.O., E.T.O., and E.A.M.E. Ribbons with 3 Bronze Stars, Good Conduct Medal, Victory Medal, Air Medal with 4 Oak Leaf Clusters, Sharpshooters Badge. Honorably Discharged December 19, 1945, at Chanute Field, Illinois.



S/Sgt. MELVIN W. MALLATT

Entered service in Marshalltown, Iowa, in National Guards, Company H., 168th Infantry, 34th Division, in February 1941. Basic training in Camp Claiborne, Louisiana, and Fort Dix, New Jersey. Not sent overseas because of Sinus infection. Sent to Camp in New York, later to Lakeland, Florida, and Greensborough, North Carolina where he was separated from U.S. Army and re-enlisted in Regular Army. Sent to Grand Island, Nebraska, and at present time is stationed at Tucson, Arizona.
