

Robinson, Reece Are Seeking Soil Commissioner Job

Glen Robinson of Buckeye and Leland Reece of New Providence have been announced as candidates for the office of commissioner for the Hardin Soil Conservation District in the election to be held at the Youth Building in Eldora on Monday, March 9.

Both Reece and Robinson are seeking the position formerly held by Kenneth Meier of Hubbard, who will not be a candidate for re-election. Meier has served as a commissioner since 1953. Other present commissioners are Dean Kelsey of Iowa Falls whose term ends in 1961, and Harold Marsh of Union, who serves until 1963.

Voting for the commissioner will take place between 7 and 9 p.m. in the wing of the Youth Building. All landlords and farm operators in Hardin county are eligible to vote.
