It was under his direction and supervision that the present profitable system was installed from a point where the town of State Center was without commercial credit, and he recalls that at one time he worked three months before he was able to draw a salary check. 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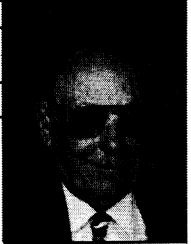

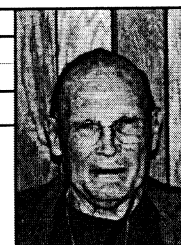

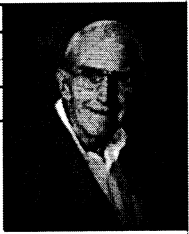
