

Teacher Conservation Camp Dates Announced

Plans are under way to hold the ninth Iowa Teachers Conservation camp at Spring Brook park near Guthrie Center again this summer. The first of three sessions begins on June 8.

THE CAMP IS a regular college course but differs in that a major portion of the instruction is done in the field. Most of the field instruction is done by guest specialists from various state and federal agencies. These field trips aid the teachers in learning conservation by observing natural resources and seeing the actual conservation practices put into use.

The courses offered are Biology 104 and 105. Biology 105 is offered the first and third sessions beginning June 8 and July 20 and the major fields emphasized are rocks and minerals, soil, water and forests. Biology 104 is offered the second session beginning June 29 and in this course soil nutrients, balance in nature and wildlife are stressed.
