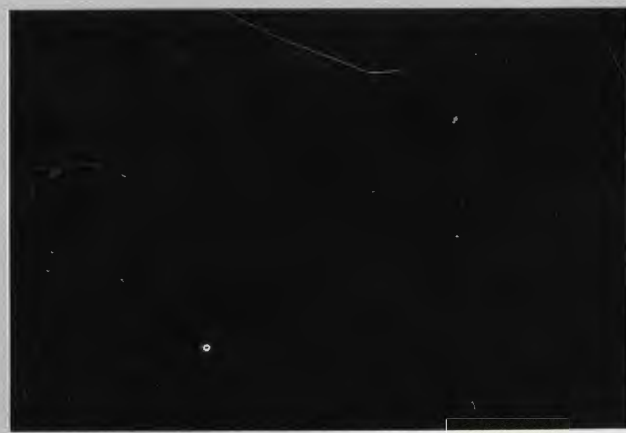
Jon Cameron Plays in McDonald's All-American Band

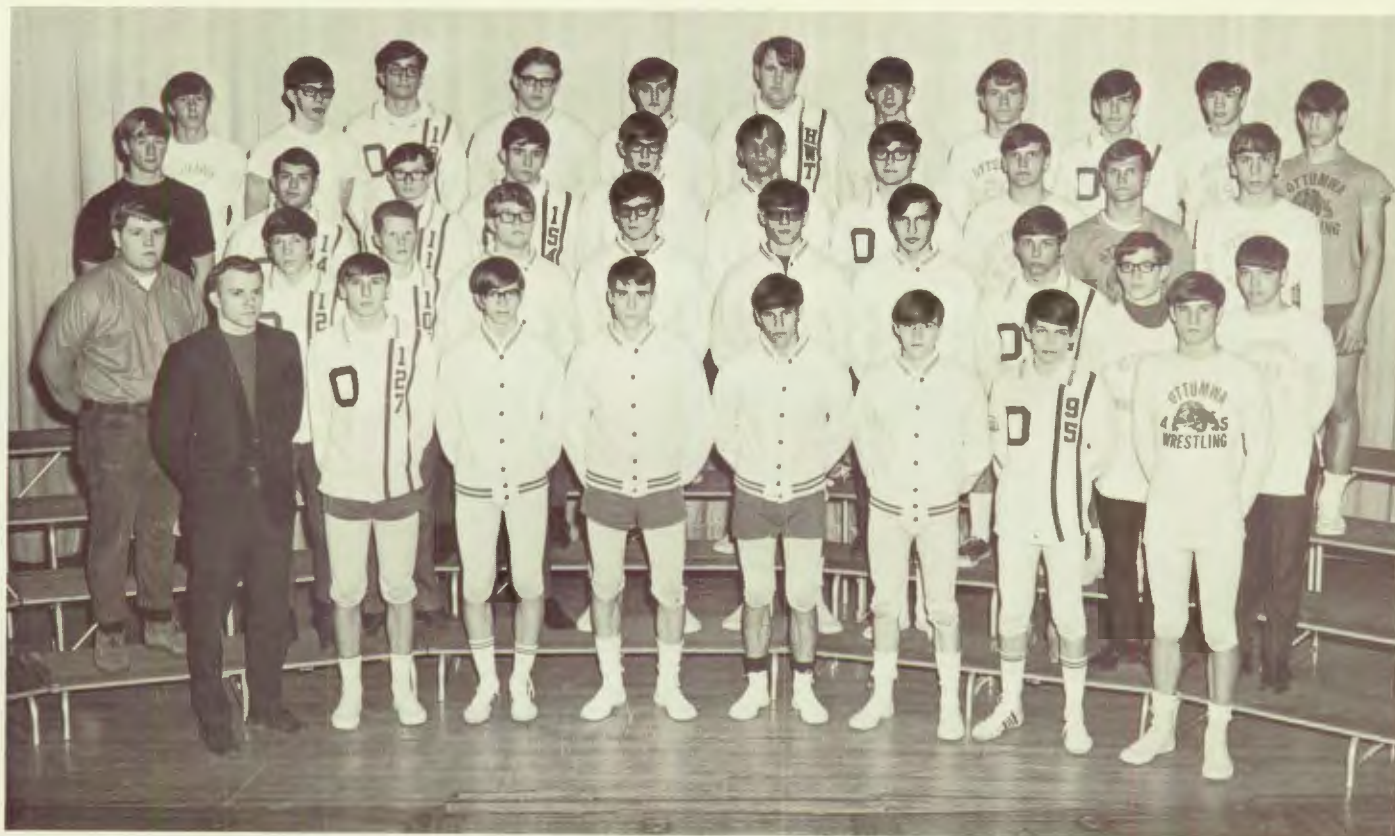

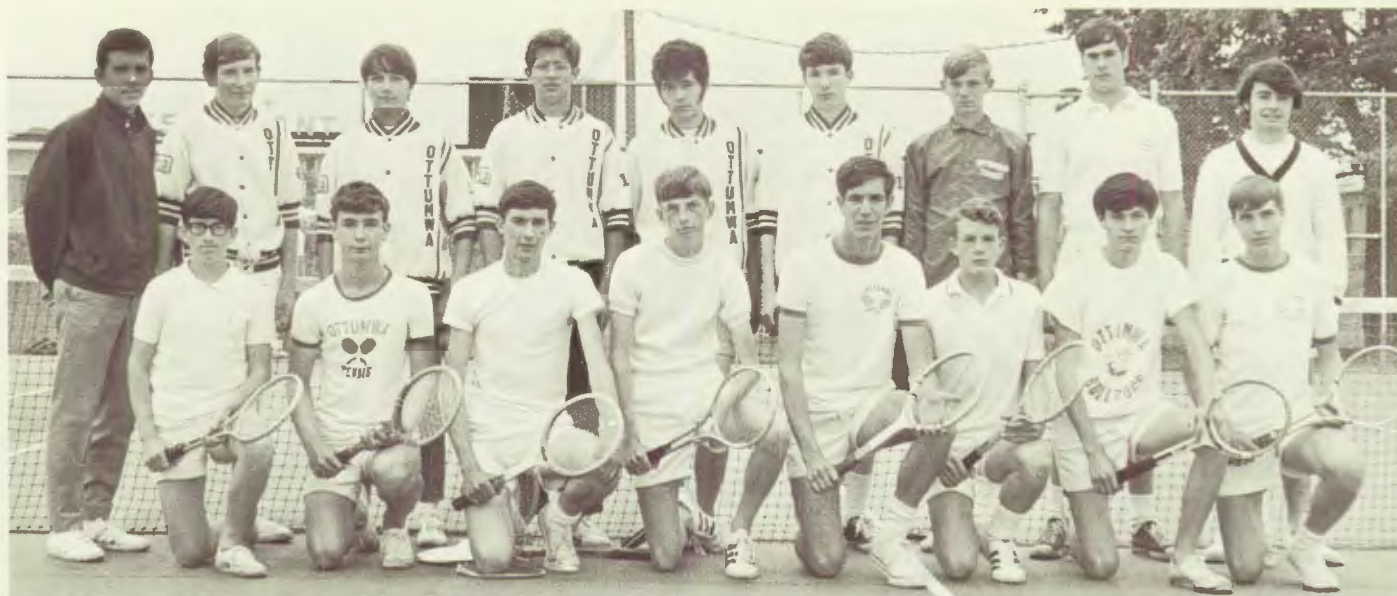

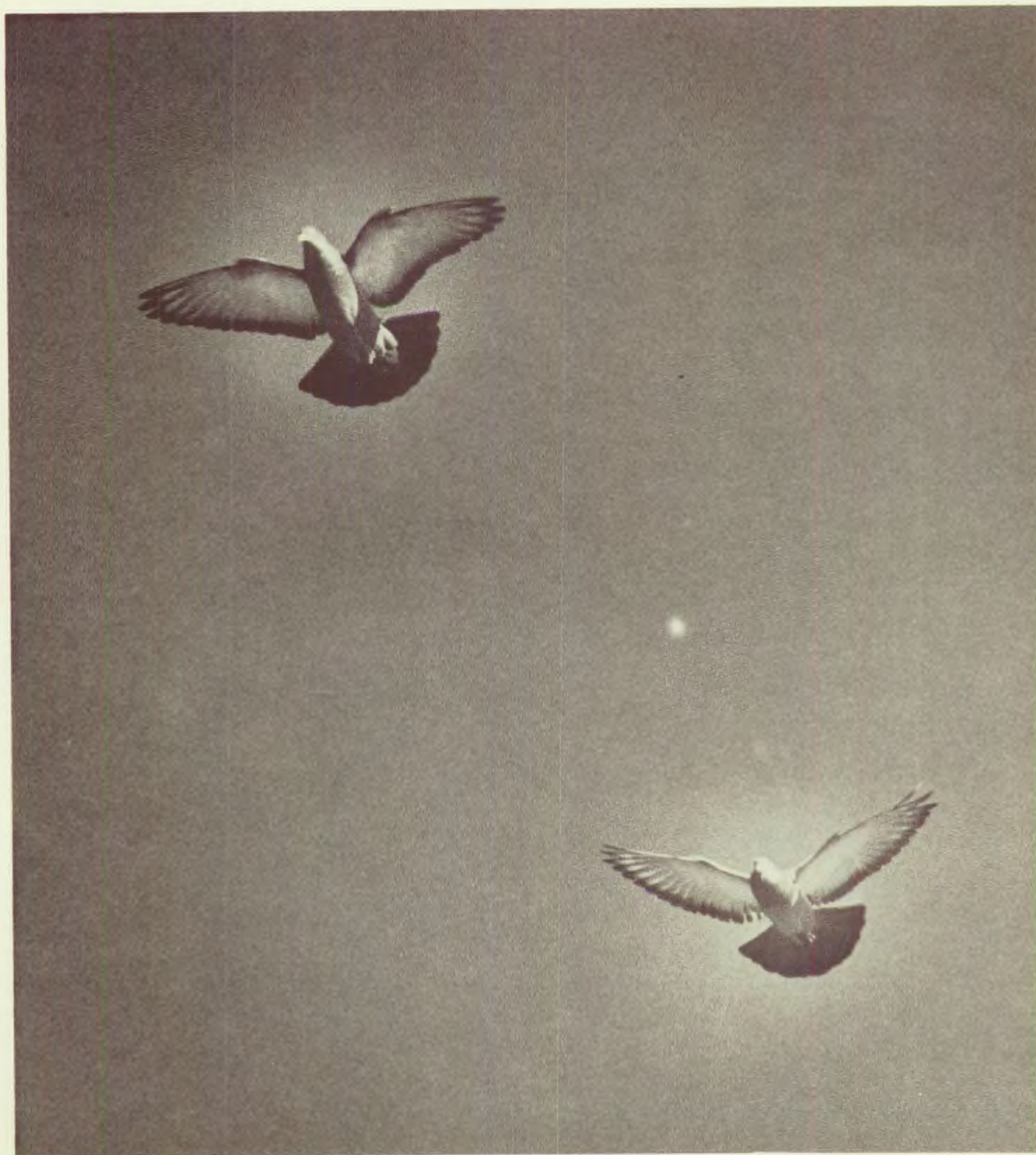
