The Mills County Resource, Conservation and Development Committee met February 8th in the Court House with Austin Bass presiding. Dave Snow briefed the group on the meetings of the Area board. Plans were made for the 5 members to attend the March meeting at Oakland for a general organizational meeting. Minutes were read and approved.

Funding to be allowed will include 100% for the technical assistance for the following projects that are approved:

Flooding-	can be up to 100%
Irrigation -	50%
Drainage-	up to 50%
Seeding, bridges, roads-	50%
Erosion Control-	50%
Soil and water management-	up to 50%
Public water- fish and wildlife-	50%
Basic structures- land rights- water quality- Manage-	
ment-	up to 100%.

Remaining costs are to be covered by individuals involved, ASCS, SCS or civic groups promoting the various projects.

Serious thought for projects will be urged through letters and news media as residents are encouraged to promote planning to be ready for action as funds are available.
