

Kreuger Wins Regional Soil Speech Contest

Larry Krueger, Radcliffe, won first place in the Regional Soil Conservation Speech Contest held Wednesday night at Nevada, according to Cal Moore of the Hardin County Soil Conservation Service.

The speech, on the topic of "How Soil Conservation Affects the Future", was judged best over entrants from a 11-county region. Earlier this year Krueger had won the locally sponsored contest. He will now advance to the State Contest to be held in Mason City this September.
