In April, 1915, she underwent an operation which served to relieve her slightly, but gradually grew worse until this morning, when a rupture of the tumor brought death.

The children are Ralph and Earl. Her parents, Mr. and Mrs. Henry Henzle, and four brothers, Edward, Albert, Henry and August, all live in or near State Center. Another brother, George, lives at Adrian, Minn.

Funeral services will be held Wednesday afternoon at 2 o'clock from St. Paul's Lutheran Evangelical church in charge of Rev. J. G. Oatman. There will be a prayer service at the home at 1 o'clock. Burial will be in Hillside.

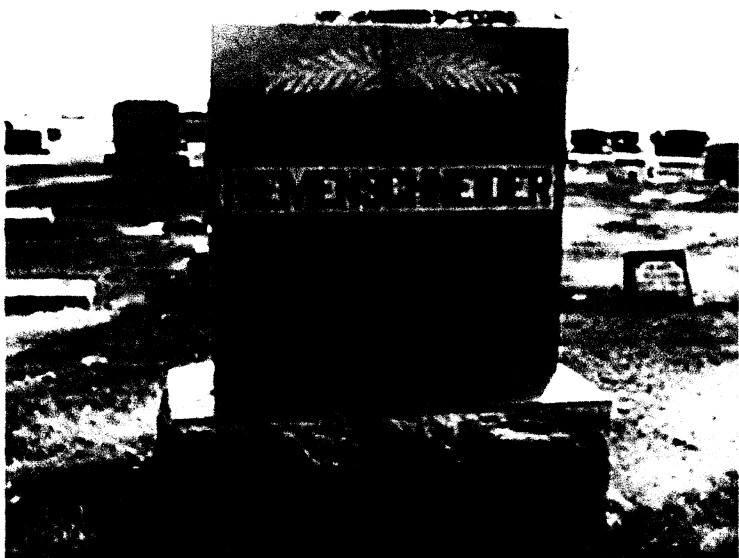

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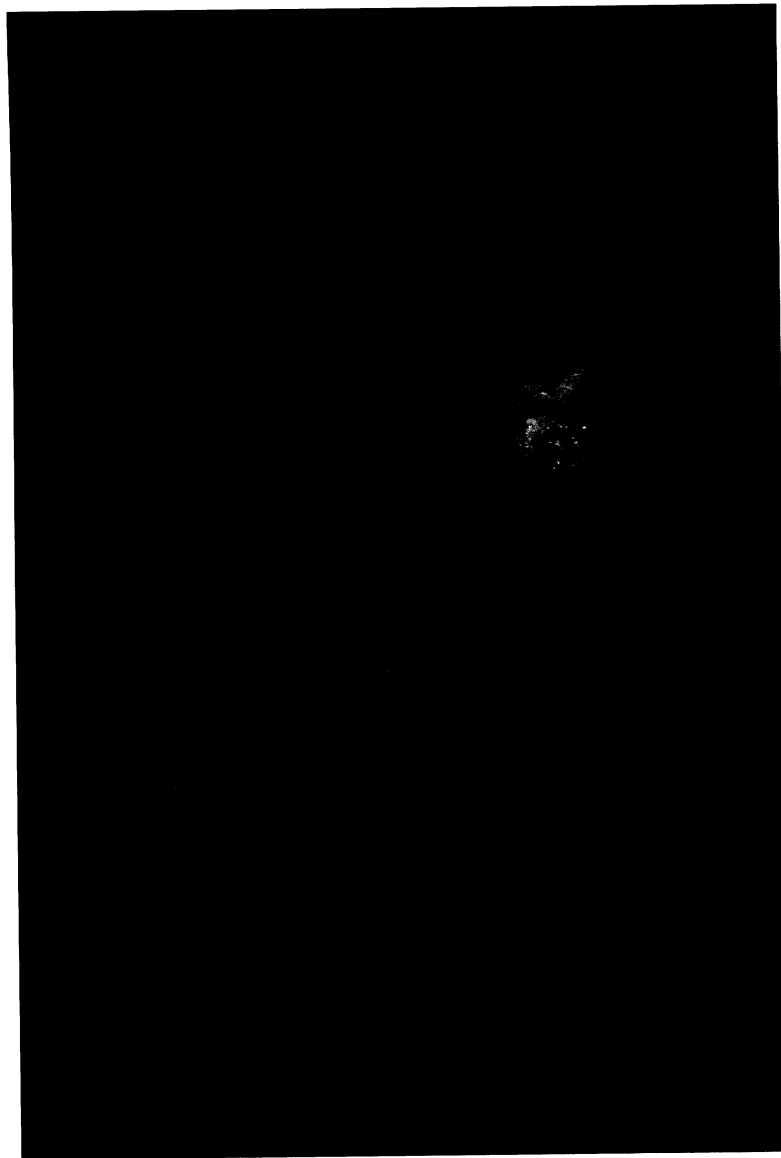
