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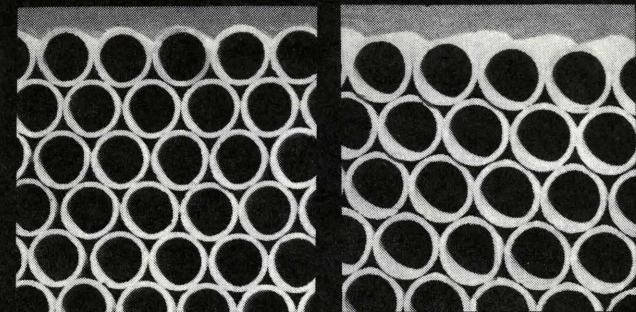

Conservation Accomplishments for 1962

POWESHIEK COUNTY

SOIL CONSERVATION DISTRICT

Almost a million feet or 186.2 miles of tile was laid in Poweshiek County during 1962.

This is enough tile to cross the State from north to south and exceeds the highest previous year by 45 miles. Much of the tiling was done on flat land requiring engineering surveys.

Approximately 7 miles of diversion and terraces were built during the year. Some of these were cut and fill parallel terraces designed to permit farming without point rows. Diversion terraces were built to protect bottomland from the damage of upland overwash.

Slightly less than 25 miles of gullies were filled, shaped and seeded to perennial grasses such as brome, fescue and canary, permitting them to be crossed with farm equipment.

Seventeen ponds and structures were built during 1962. The ponds will provide a dependable convenient source of water for livestock. The structures were built to control gullies on larger watersheds.

Fingerling bass, bluegills and channel catfish were distributed to 22 pond owners in the county by the Federal Fish and Wildlife Service. These were without cost to the owner.

Over 2000 acres of new contour farming and strip cropping was staked and 512 acres of permanent pastures were improved.

Complete conservation plans were developed on 33 farms with the assistance of SCS technicians of the Poweshiek District.

This free planning service includes a complete soil map of the farm showing soil types, percent slope, amount of topsoil plus the assistance of a trained conservationist who will help in planning and applying of any conservation practices needed, such as terraces, cropping systems, strip cropping, waterways, ponds and structures.

The soil District received requests from 44 farmers for such assistance during the year.

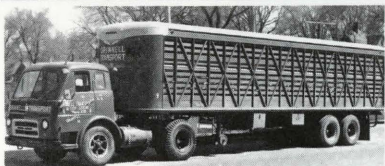

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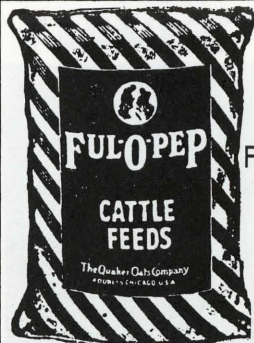
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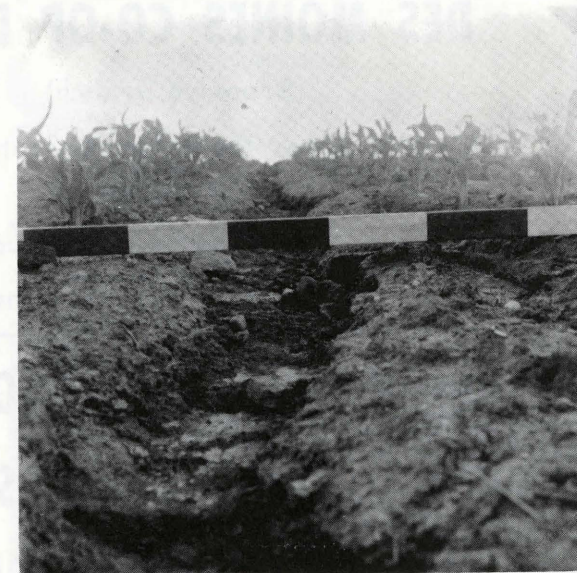

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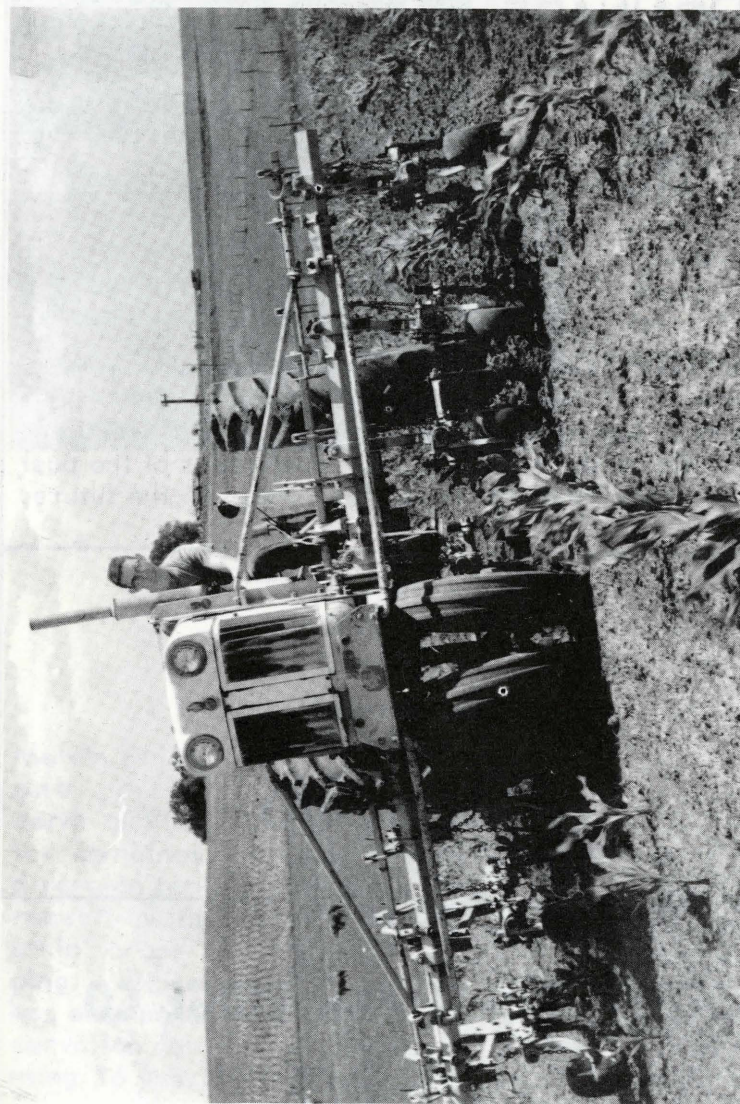

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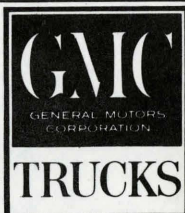


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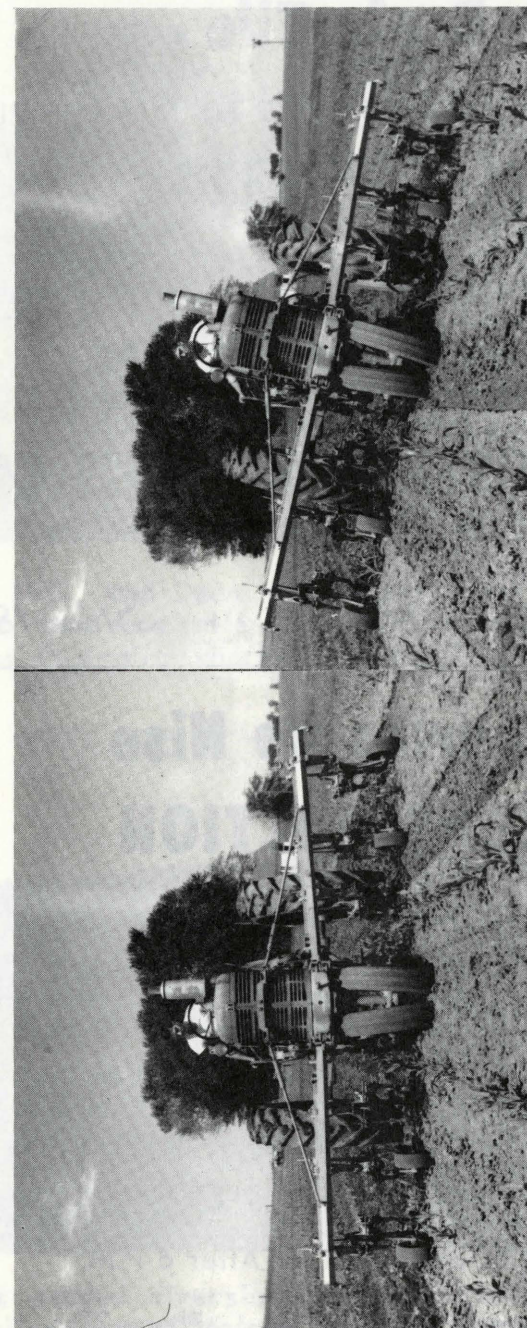

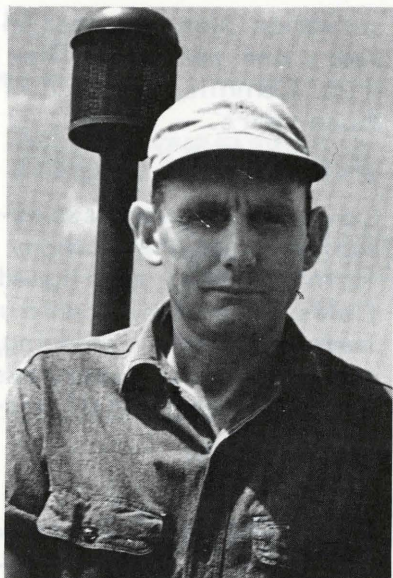
Conservation practices established on the Anthony farm include; re-aligned fields, rotation, contour farming, strip cropping, terraces, grass waterways and birdsfoot trefoil pasture.

Anthony was also declared sweepstakes winner, Region V of the State Contest.

Edward Henry, operator of the Louis Newkirk farm, three miles northeast of Barnes City, co-winner of Division II, Conservation Achievement Award Program.

Division II recognizes landlords and tenants who

have made outstanding progress in soil conservation through joint effort. The owner L.V. Newkirk is an industrial Arts Administrator in Chicago Public Schools.

The conservation plan was developed 7 years ago. Fences were removed, ridges leveled, a rotation developed, waterways shaped, tiled and seeded, poor hill-sides seeded to improved grasses, and strip cropping set up as the principal cropland practice.

The farm has improved consistently in productivity and appearance.

Phil Eichhorn, Brooklyn, winning entry in Division III, Conservation Achievement Awards Program.

The Division III award goes to the farmer who has made unusually rapid progress in installing conservation practices on the farm.

The 105-acre farm considered for the award is located 7 miles south of Brooklyn, and is operated by son James.

Practices installed on the Eichhorn farm are: re-organized fields, fence ridge leveling, improved rotation, strip cropping, birds-foot trefoil pasture, tree planting, one mile of diversion terrace, farm pond and extensive bottomland drainage.
