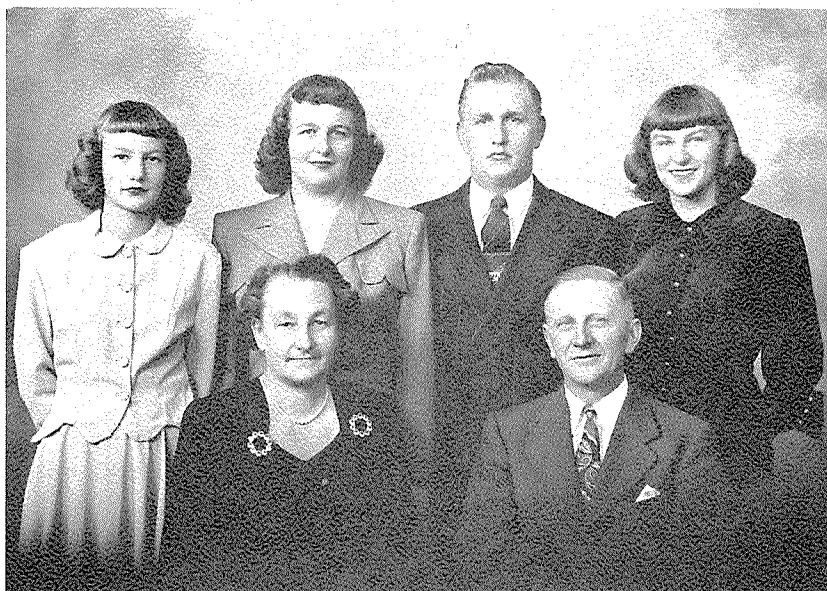

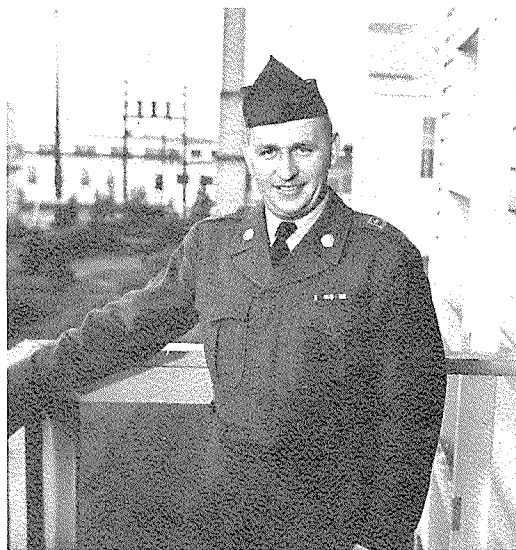

SUELWOLD

Records vary in spelling and it has been written as SILVOLD - SILWOLDT - SILLWOLD and SILWOLT. I am using the version SILWOLD after the first few generations as they did in Iowa. Birth records of the original family are from the Parish Hohenhausen, Lippe - Detmold, Germany.

The parents lived at #9 Hohenhausen meaning that it was the 9th house built in the village. By some error, the name Wilhelmine was not registered with the rest. I found her records here in Wisconsin. Apparently, Sophia was first to come to America because she married here in 1850. Her brother Johann "Heinrich" migrated in 1852 and she was already married and her first child was born that year. It seems doubtful that the parents ever came - Johann Heinrich was already 30 when he came in 1852 and perhaps they were not alive anymore.

Wilhelmine married Kord "Heinrich" Suelberg (spelled Selberg by the younger generations). An old plat map of Town Herman shows that the farms of Suelwold and Suelberg lay side by side - not far from the Wehrmann Homestead.

You will notice that most of the names are familiar ones in Town Herman which is not strange since they first lived there, then went to Iowa. Again, you will find a similarity to the names of the Wehrmann's who lived in the same area near Baxter, in Jasper County. There are many relationships. The Lipper's were a group who kept to themselves and married one of their own. Thus the relationships are interwoven so that it is difficult to sort them all out.

Areas of this family records are incomplete due to lack of knowledge.

I have tried to fill in the names that are familiar, both in the Henry Wehrmann family and the Silwold family, both of Iowa. Many names and boundries were faded or were not clear enough to copy so those areas are left blank. Question marks indicate a question in the correct spelling. Many of these landowners first settled in Sheboygan County, Wisconsin, and later migrated west to Iowa.

KORD "HEINRICH" SELBERG It is said that he was a very strong, powerful man. He slaughtered the animals for his neighbors at butchering time. The story is told of how he was walking on the road at about 4:30 A.M., heading for a distant farm when he was persued by a wolf. He swung his axe with his strong arms and killed the wolf.

FREDERICK SELBERG According to his Certificate of Service in the National Archives, Frederick Selberg enlisted in the Civil War on August 21, 1862 for 3 years in service. He served in Company C of the 27th Regiment of Wisconsin Infantry, having been mustered in on October 25, 1862 at Milwaukee.

He was a resident of Town Hermann in Sheboygan County. Further records show that his age was 20 years, he had blue eyes, dark hair and dark complexion, was 5 ft. 3 in. tall, and was by occupation a carpenter.

Frederick Selberg died on April 10, 1863 at Little Rock, Arkansas of fever.

CONRAD SELBERG He moved to Outagamie County and purchased a farm in the Center Township (now Black Creek Township). In 1914, he sold his farm to Louis Wehrman, son of his first cousin, Simon Wehrmann who lived in Town Center. Simon Wehrmann was the son of Sophia Louise Silwold and Frederick "Karl" Wehrmann.

AUGUST SELBERG It has been said that he moved to California and married, late in life, to a women who had a daughter by a former marriage. She made his life miserable, pressuring him to sign over property to her daughter. In dispair, he asked his cousin, Simon Wehrmann, what he would do. His cousin said, jokingly, "I would change my name to Simon Wehrmann and disappear". Hearing no more about it, Simon forgot his joking reply. He did not hear from August again. Some years later, Simon heard of his death through an attorney who told him that he had changed his name to Simon Wehrmann and everything that he had went to his cousin, Simon. Since it was already in his name, it didn't even have to go to court. Of the wife, her search for him was fruitless and we will never know the end of her story.

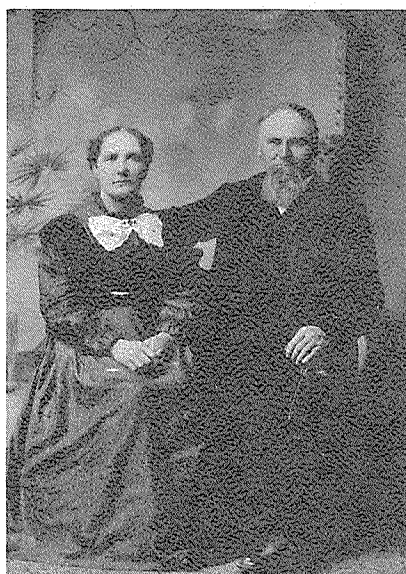

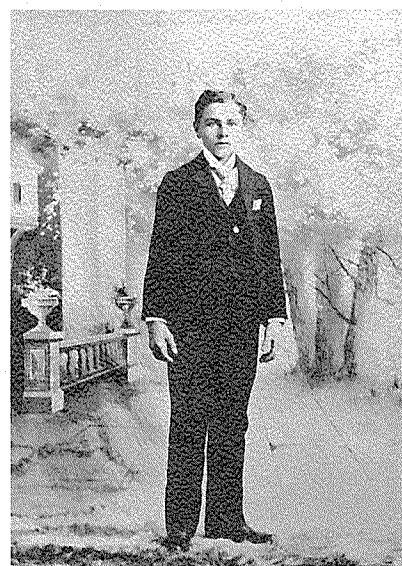

HENRY KRAMPE, oldest son of Henry and Louisa Silwold Krampe, was born in Sheboygan, Wisconsin, December 7, 1853 and died at his home in Baxter on January 10, 1926 having attained the age of 72 years, 1 month, and 3 days. At the age of 13 years, he came with his parents to Jasper County, settling on what is now the August Krampe farm, where he lived until his marriage in 1881 to Miss Helen Hager of Waukon, who survives him, together with the five children born this union, Mrs. Karl Brandt, Marshalltown; Elmer Krampe, White River, S.D., Mrs. William Kruse, Charles City; Wesley Krampe, on the home farm and Marguerite Krampe, Buffalo Center, Iowa.

Following their marriage Mr. and Mrs. Krampe lived for about 8 years on the farm now owned by Henry Miller, after which they purchased the farm one mile south of town, where they resided until 9 years ago, when they moved to town since which time the home farm has been rented by their son, Wesley.

At the age of 14 Mr. Krampe was confirmed in the St. John's Evangelical Church and all his life he has been active in church circles, uniting with the First Congregational Church of Baxter about two years ago.

Mr. Krampe, throughout his entire life, has followed the occupation of farming and is recognized as one of the successful agriculturists of the community, having by dint of hard work amassed a considerable amount of this worlds goods. Even since retiring from active work he has continued to retain his interest in the farm, and much of his time was spent there. He was also a stockholder and director in the State Savings Bank and took his part in the management of its affairs.

Possessed of much musical ability and gifted with a fine voice, Mr. Krampe was passionately fond of music and made it a study through out his entire life. He was ever prominent in musical circles and gave most freely of his time and talent in this direction, and his loss will be sorely felt in the church choir and in the quartet of which he was so long a member.

HENRY KRAMPE. Among the successful farmers of Jasper County who, through unaided exertions and the exercise of perseverance and economy have risen from humble positions in youth to posts of honor and influence, may be mentioned the name of Mr. Krampe, a well known resident of Malaka Township. The farm which he owns and upon which he conducts general agricultural pursuits is one of the best in the township and consists of 154 acres of valuable land. During the 26 years he has spent upon this place, he has succeeded in bringing the soil to a high state of cultivation and has erected a number of substantial and conveniently arranged buildings.

The parents of our subject, Henry and Fredericka (Depping) Krampe, the former of whom was a shoemaker by trade. In the spring of 1851 he brought the family to America and located in Wisconsin where he bought a heavily timbered farm of 400 acres. Of this property he cleared 160 acres and to each of his sons gave an 80 acre tract. In 1867 he came to Iowa and brought 380 acres in Makaka township, Jasper County, where he continued to reside until his death. His life was one of industry and energy, and he was highly esteemed by all who knew him.

The subject of this sketch was born in Lippe-Detmold, Germany, Sept. 12, 1824 and passed his boy hood days in a comparatively uneventful manner. In 1852 he was united in marriage with Miss Louisa Sillwolt, and unto them have been born six children, namely, Henry, Fred, Simon, August, Mina and Louisa, the latter being the wife of August Klemme. In politics Mr. Krampe takes an active interest in public affairs and affiliates with the Republican party. While residing in Germany he was a reserve in the Revolution. In his religious belief he is identified with the German Reformed Church, to which his family also belongs.

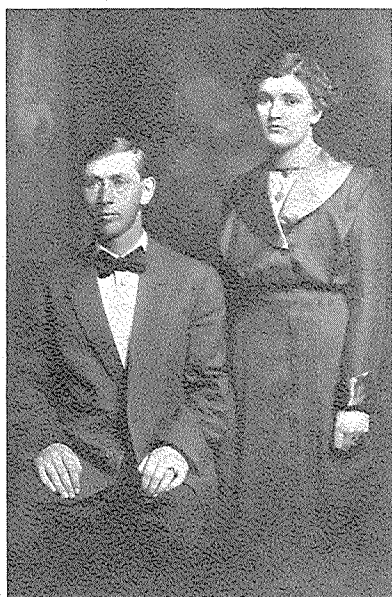

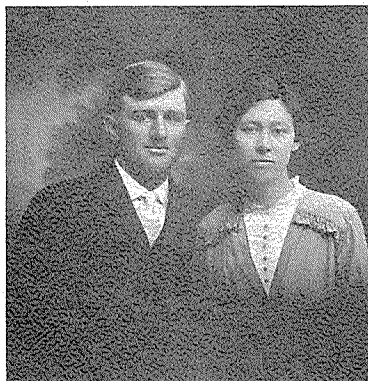

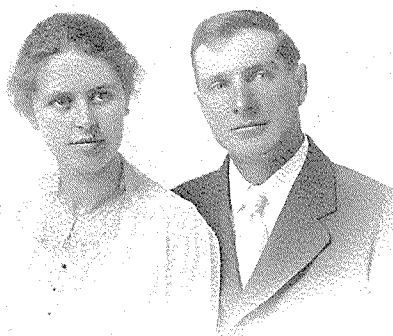

From there, we are unable to find any trace of her. Apparently, in 1865 when Frederick wrote to his brother in America, she must already have been dead. He asks about the members of the family but does not mention her name. I have made an exhaustive search through church records, both Immanuel and Saran and in Germany but there just isn't anything. I have come to the conclusion that she must have died in a short time after arrival - as her mother did. Records were not kept that early and she may be interred somewhere on either the Wehrmann or Reineking farm as are both of her parents. It is possible that we may never know.

Introduction to family data on the sixth child for Franz Dietrich "Karl" and Anna Maria Multhaupt Wehrmann:

Johann "Frederick" Conrad did not come to America but stayed in his native land. He lived in Lemgo and was a teacher at Horstmar. At the beginning of this chapter, you will find translations to the letters that he wrote to his brother Karl in America. They were found in possession of Karl's son years later. I have decided to have you read these letters first to give you an insight into the goodness of this man and to feel, as I did, the love which shines out between the lines.

Following the translation are the copies of the old letters themselves as he wrote them in beautiful script.

The pictures for this section are furnished by the descendants of Johann "Frederick" Wehrmann, the Schafmeisters and come from Lemgo, Lippe-Bochum in the Ruhr Valley and Bremen on the Weser River and incidently the port of departure for our ancestors when they came to America.

You will be interested to know that a copy of this complete book is going to each of the two Schafmeister families. I hope that we will make as good an impression on them as they have on us!

The following are translations of the two beautifully written letters, written on May 28, 1865 and June 18, 1866, respectively. They were written to Frederick "Karl" Wehrmann, in America, by his brother, Johann "Frederick" Wehrmann, who remained in Germany. His home was in Lemgo, Lippe.

The first letter does not have pages 1 and 2. Apparently they were lost. Thus, the letter starts in the middle of a sentence.

I am sure that your reading of them will be an emotional experience. I am not ashamed to admit that the tears rolled down by cheeks when I first read them.

Letter 1

We have progressed in our studies rather very far ahead, otherwise I would have suggested to study English first; I believe, this would have been easier for us. "Children!" I said, yes, dear Karl! On March 12 of this year, our Lord has given us again a little girl, and we have two children again. The little daughter will be 11 weeks old tomorrow, she resembles very much poor late Pauline. She is very patient and quiet, but at the moment she is rather critically ill. She has a cough, must often vomit as a result of this, her chest is plugged with phlegm. This
