SUPPLEMENT 3 to APPENDIX A

SECTION IV. EMERGENCY CONSERVATION PRACTICES

Section IV, Appendix A, Supplement 1 is amended to include Practice F-4-B(11) to read as follows:

F-4-B(11) RESTORATION OF FARM PONDS FOR LIVESTOCK WATER

Applicable in the designated disaster counties listed for Practice F-4-B(1) in Supplement 1 to Appendix A - Iowa.

Federal cost-sharing may be authorized to reconstruct farm ponds which were destroyed or materially impaired by flood and excessive run-off in the spring of 1965. This is for ponds constructed for livestock water to obtain proper distribution of livestock and encourage rotation grazing and better grassland management as a means of protecting established vegetative cover.

Specifications for this practice will be the same as for the B-7 practice in the 1965 State ACP Handbook.

The Soil Conservation Service will be responsible for all technical phases of this practice.

FEDERAL COST-SHARE:

- (a) 80 percent of the cost of earthmoving.
- (b) 80 percent of the cost of repair of mechanical spillway.

SECTION VI. INCREASED RATES OF COST-SHARING

Section VI, Appendix A, Supplement 1 is amended to include Practice F-4-B(11).

F-4-B(11) RESTORATION OF FARM PONDS FOR LIVESTOCK WATER

FEDERAL COST-SHARE:

- (a) 80 percent of the cost of earthmoving.
- (b) 80 percent of the cost of repair of mechanical spillway.
