

Thursday Meeting To Prepare For '59 ASC Election

The 1959 Hardin County ASC election will be set up Thursday evening, May 14, at a meeting in the county extension office in Eldora. Official members of the Hardin County ASC election board are James Goode, county extension director, chairman; Cal Moore, Eldora SCS work unit conservationist; Howard Sisam, Iowa Falls, Farm Bureau president; Neil Baker, Alden, Farmers Union president; Dewey Eller, Hubbard, County ASC chairman; and Gaylord Thayer, ASC office manager at Iowa Falls who will also meet with the election board.

Thursday night's meeting, according to Goode, will be to name a three-man community election board in each township; to select a county election board secretary; to appoint a county election tabulation board; to designate a place for farmers to return their ballots and to determine the location of a county convention to elect the 1959 Hardin County Agriculture Conservation Committee.

The ASC election will be conducted by mail during the periods June 26 through July 7. The county convention will be held July 25.

Farmers in each township will have a choice of voting on ten candidates, named by the township election boards.
