All the students at Ankeny High wish Margarita the best of luck in the future.



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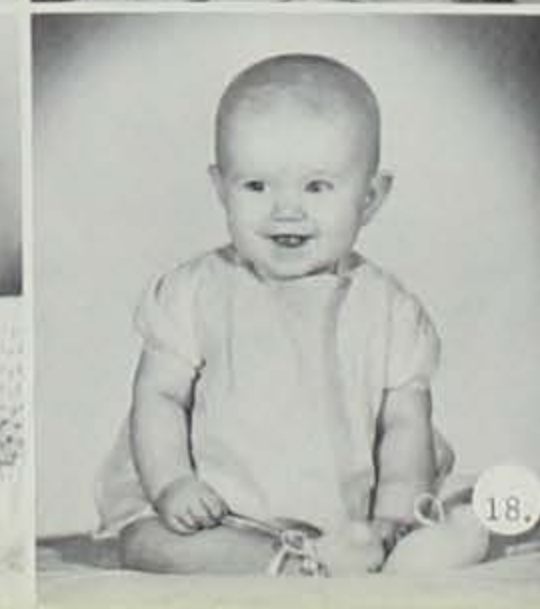

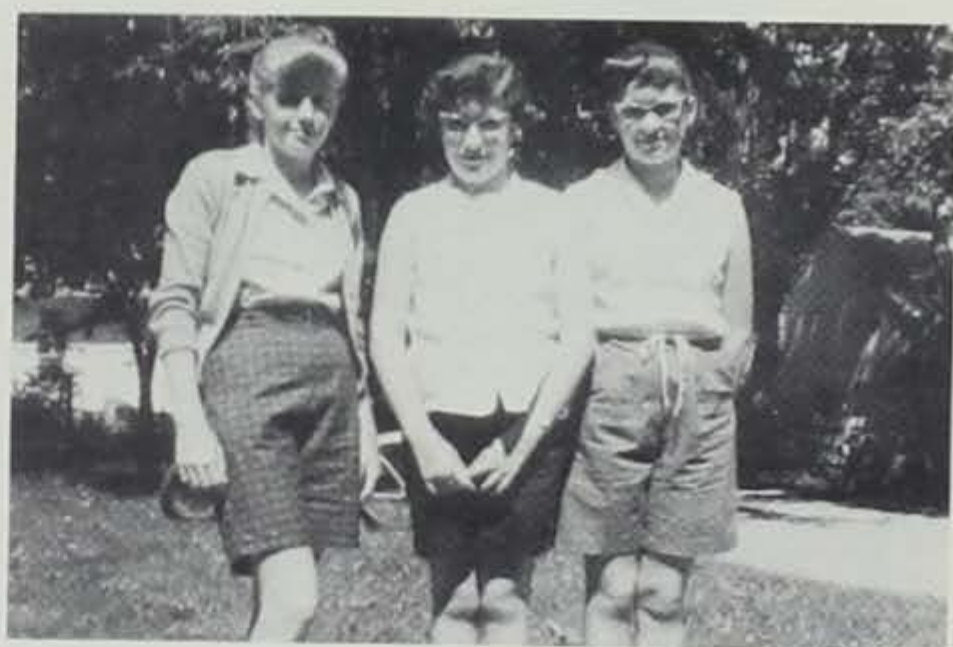

It is also interesting to note that DICK PELTZ just managed,

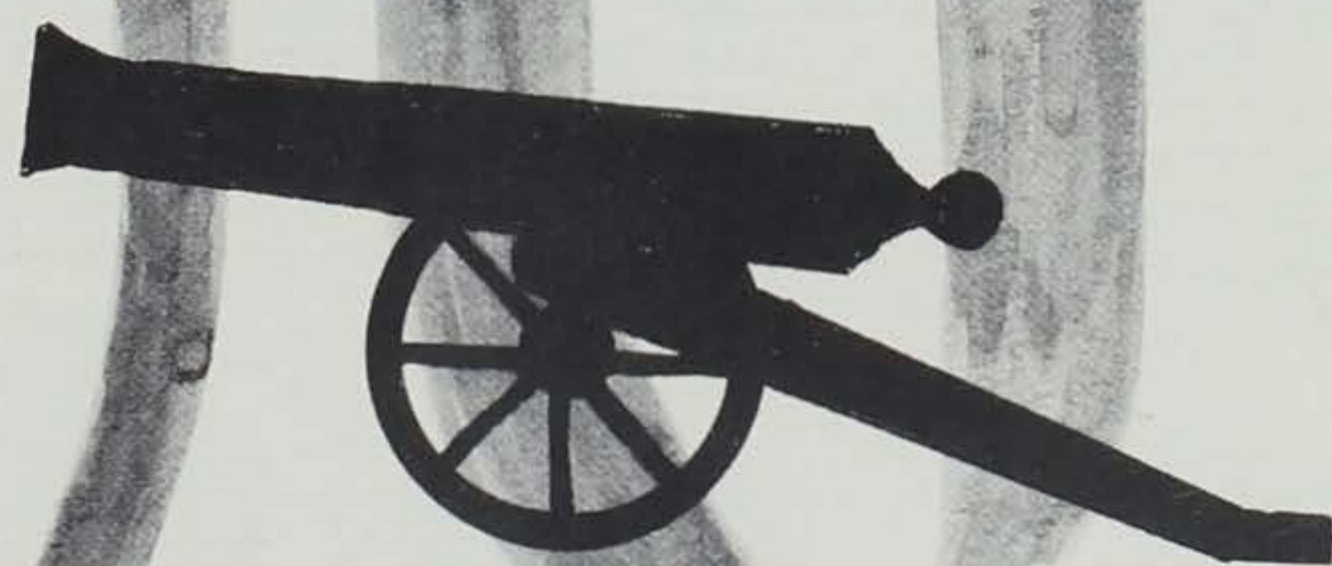

National Honor Society

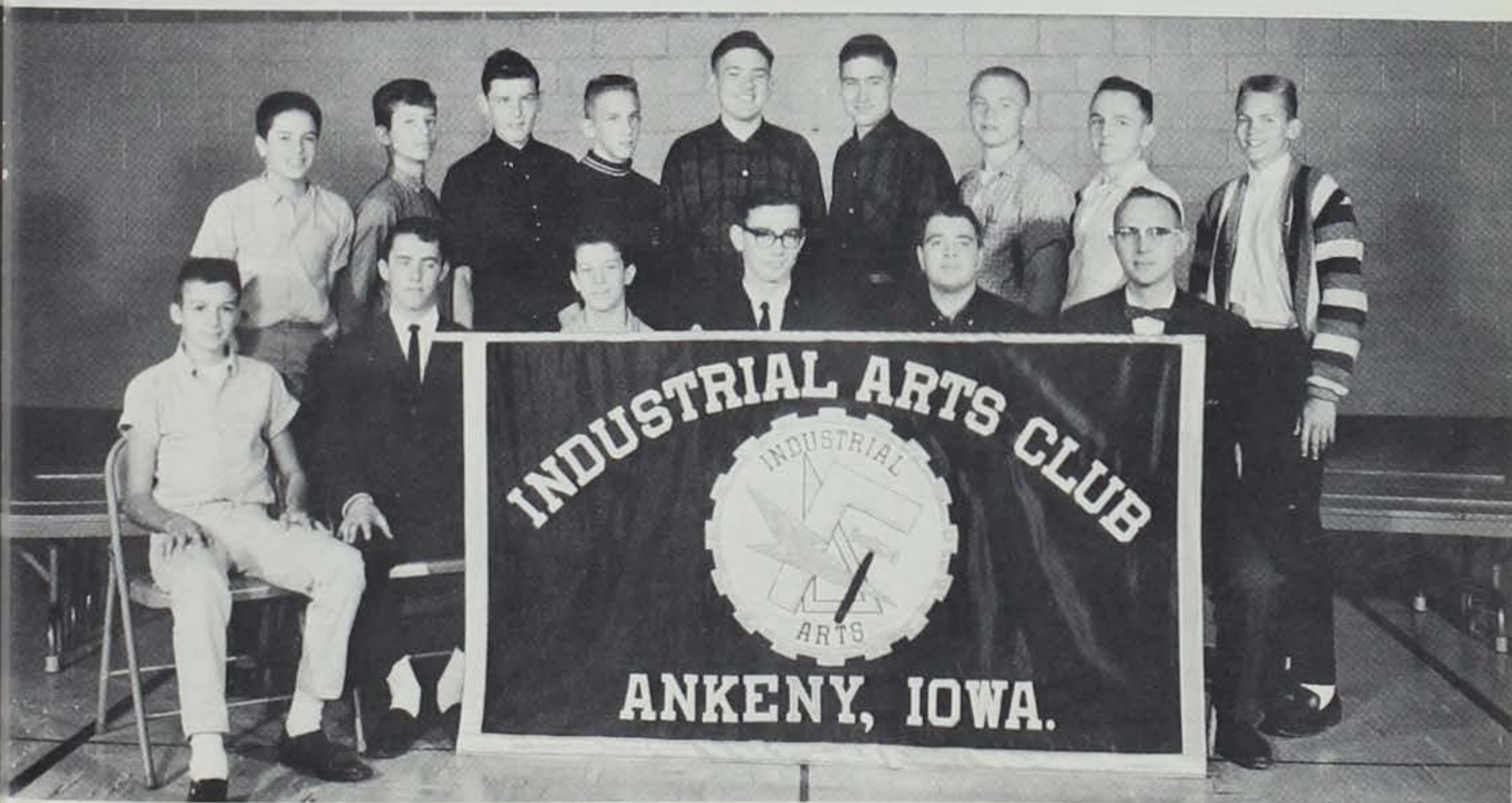
