

Ruth Lamer Now At Conservation Camp

Ruth Lamer of Eldora is presently spending three weeks at Springbrook State Park. She is attending the Iowa Teachers Conservation Camp sponsored jointly by the State Conservation Commission, Iowa State

Teachers College and the Department of Public Instruction. At this course she will learn conservation by taking field trips led by a number of the best experts in the state. Ruth Lamer and approximately 150 other teachers from all parts of Iowa are having the opportunity of attending the tenth year of this outdoor school, which was the first of its kind in America. There are three sessions of three weeks each year.

Duane E. DeKock of the State Conservation Commission has informed us that the teachers are staying in the cabins at the state park. Much of the work is in the park, but during the three week session they will travel close to one thousand miles to study various areas of interest. Ruth Lamer will be at this camp from July 19 to Aug. 8.
