ERNEST RIEMENSCHNEIDER DIES AT IOWA CITY HOSPITAL APRIL 2

Ernest L. Riemenschneider, 78, retired State Center farmer, passed away at the University hospital in Iowa City, Thursday morning, April 2nd following a long illness. He had been confined to the hospital for some time.

Funeral services were held Monday afternoon at the home at one thirty o'clock followed by services at St. Paul Lutheran church at two o'clock in charge of the Rev. Ehmer J. Braun. Interment was in Hillside cemetery.

Pallbearers were Harold Mahlow, John Briney, Leo Bergman, Dan Shortley, Keith Miller and Earl Heller. Flower bearers were Edith Mahlow, Frances Stone, Florence Briney Mable Moody, Doris Davis, Ruth Hartwig, Dorothy Muench and Marilyn Wilkening.

Ernest Riemenschneider was born January 18, 1875 near French Grove, the son of William and Mary Ann Wantz Riemenschneider. He was baptized and confirmed in St. John's Lutheran church and later joined St. Paul church.

On January 3, 1901 he was united in marriage to Emma Henze and they were the parents of two sons, Ralph and Earl. Following his wife's death in 1916, Mr. Riemenschneider moved to State Center and made his home with his mother until November 14, 1923 when he married Ruby Riemenschneider of Kingsley at Sioux City. They have made their home in State Center since that time.

In addition to his wife and sons, Ralph of Pleasantville, N. Y., and Earl of State Center, he is survived by five grandchildren; two great grandchildren; four sisters, Mrs. Albert Weuve, Mrs. Oscar Buschbom, Mrs. Clara Edwards and Mrs. James Figgins, all of State Center, and two brothers, George and Louis, both of Marshalltown.

Ruby Riemenschneider, 98, a long-time State Center resident died at the State Center Nursing and Rehabilitation Center on Saturday morning, April 6, 2002.

Funeral services were held on Tuesday, April 9 at St. Paul Lutheran Church in State Center with Pastor Ronald Darge officiating. Burial followed in the Hillside Cemetery in State Center.

She was born in Plymouth County, Iowa, on April 6, 1904, the daughter of Henry S. and Anna Gehrig Riemenschneider.

On Nov. 14, 1923 in Sioux City, Iowa, she was united in marriage to Ernest Riemenschneider. He preceded her in death in April of 1953.

There is a sister, Evelyn Riemenschneider of Sioux City surviving. Also two nieces, Frances Penrose and Robinette Grady, both of California. There

are also several great nieces and nephews.

Also surviving are very special friends and caretakers Don and Judy Mahlow and LaVern and Nola German, all of State Center.

Preceding Ruby in death were her parents and one sister, Lurena Roeder.

Reared and educated in Kingsley, Iowa, she graduated from high school there. Following her schooling, she was married to Mr. Riemenschneider and they moved to State Center where she helped him with the farm. After moving into town, she lived in her own home for many years before moving to the Manor.

Her memberships include the St. Paul Lutheran Church and a member of the Women of the Moose since 1959. When she was able she was the Fish Fryer for many years at the Moose Lodge.
