

Meeting to address concerns over Highway 58 construction

CEDAR FALLS — An informational public hearing on environmental issues related to Highway 58 construction will be at 7 p.m. Monday at the Community Meeting Room of Cedar Falls Utilities, 612 E. 12th St.

Sponsored by the Cedar River Festival Inc., the meeting will include discussion from representatives of several groups, including the Iowa Department of Transportation, the Iowa Department of Natural Resources and Cedar Falls Utilities. Also invited are representatives of Allied Construction Co. and Peterson Construction Co.

John Konefes, director of the Iowa

Waste Education Center at the University of Northern Iowa, will moderate the meeting.

The meeting is being held in response to public concern raised over erosion and other construction-related environmental impact to Dry Run Creek, the Cedar River and other natural resources in the project corridor.

The Cedar River Festival Inc. is a non-profit organization that works to promote public education concerning the Cedar River and its tributaries as natural and recreational resources, as well as to increase public concern for the water quality of the Cedar River.

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
