STATE CENTER MAN FOUND DEAD IN BED

Well Known Resident of This Community Victim of Heart Failure Monday Night

Failing to get any response when she attempted to call her son, William F. Riemenschneider, to breakfast Tuesday morning, Mrs. Mary Riemenschneider entered the room to find Mr. Riemenschneider lying dead in bed, with his four-year-old son, Roscoe, asleep beside him.

To all appearances Mr. Riemenschneider died without a struggle of any sort. His son slept soundly beside him, knowing nothing of his father's death. Death was pronounced due to heart failure and it is thought that Mr. Riemenschneider had not been feeling well for several days, although he had complained but little.

Mr. Riemenschneider was a son of the late William Riemenschneider and since the death of his wife, March 8, 1914, had been living with his mother.

Mr. Riemenschneider was born in Minerva township March 14, 1873. He was united in marriage to Miss Alice Nauke Dec. 15, 1910. In addition to his mother and little son, Mr. Riemenschneider is survived by three brothers and five sisters. They are Ernest, George W. and Louis Riemenschneider of State Center; Mrs. Martin Burish of Van Cleve and Mesdames Albert Weuve, Oscar Buschbom, Louis Edwards and James Figgins, all of State Center.

A large number of sorrowing friends and relatives attended the funeral this afternoon. The services were conducted by Rev. Oltmann. Burial was made in Hillside cemetery.

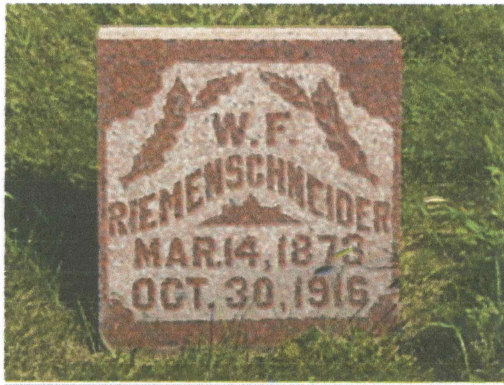

YOUNG MOTHER DIES.

Mrs. W. F. Riemenschneider, State Center, Succumbs to Childbirth.

Death at 4:30 Tuesday afternoon claimed Mrs. Alice Riemenschneider, wife of William F. Riemenschneider, a young farmer living one-half mile west of State Center. Mrs. Riemenschneider's death was due to childbirth, and occurred at the home of her sister, Mrs. W. F. Miller, one-half mile south of State Center. The babe was born dead.

Mrs. Riemenschneider was born Alice Nauke on a farm one mile northwest of State Center. She attended school in State Center, and was graduated from the high school with the class of 1902. On Dec. 13, 1910, Miss Nauke became the wife of Mr. Riemenschneider. The couple has lived until recently on a farm one and one-half miles east of State Center. This place Mr. Riemenschneider sold and bought a farm west of town. Mrs. Riemenschneider was a member of the Methodist church of State Center.

Aside from her husband Mrs. Riemenschneider is survived by one son, Robbie, aged 2. Her father, P. W. Nauke, one mile northwest of State Center; one brother, Max Nauke, and two sisters, Mrs. Roy Carney and Mrs. Miller, of State Center, also survive.

Funeral services will be held Friday afternoon at 1 o'clock from the W. F. Miller home, and at 2 o'clock from the Methodist church. Rev. C. J. Rose officiating. Burial will be in Hillside, where the mother and her babe will lie in one grave.

Mrs. W. F. Riemenschneider was born October 17, 1884, and was the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. W. F. Nauke. She lived all her life in this community and received her education in the State Center high school, from where she graduated with the class of 1903. She lived a quiet and obedient member of the M. E. church from the date of joining until her death, which occurred at the home of her sister, Mrs. W. F. Miller, March 8. She was married December 15, 1910, to W. F. Riemenschneider, and was the mother of two children. One, a son about two years old, survives with his father. The other, also a son, was laid to rest with his mother. She is also survived by two sisters and one brother, Max Nauke, Mrs. Roy Carney and Mrs. Miller. Funeral services were held at the M. E. church on March 5, Rev. C. J. Rose, the pastor, officiating. Interment followed in Hillside cemetery.

COURT GIVES CHILD TO AUNT.

**Mrs. Emma Carney, of State Center,
Wins 4-Year-Old Nephew.**

In a ruling made by Judge Cummings Wednesday Mrs. Emma Carney, of State Center, was appointed guardian of the person of her 4-year-old nephew, Roscoe Reimenschneider, of State Center, who was left an orphan when his father, William F. Reimenschneider, died a few weeks ago.

As a contestant in the application for guardianship, at a hearing that was held in Judge Cummings' chambers here Saturday, was the child's grandmother, Mrs. Mary Reimenschneider. Judge Cummings indicated in his letter to J. L. Carney, that contained the ruling, that he might appoint Louis Reimenschneider, of State Center, a relative of the child, guardian of the baby's property. The child came into possession of 160 acres of land and some personal property upon the death of his father.

GUARDIANSHIP IS AFFIRMED.

**Supreme Court Upholds Appointment
in Case of State Center Baby.**

The litigation between State Center relatives for the possession of 4-year-old Roscoe Riemenschneider, an orphan which was carried to the supreme court, has been decided by the higher court, which has affirmed the appointment made by Judge Cummings late last year. Judge Cummings appointed Mrs. Emma Carney, an aunt of the child, to be guardian of his person. Louis Riemenschneider was already guardian of the baby's property, which includes land and \$12,000 in money.

An effort was made by Mrs. Mary Reimenschneider, grandmother of the child, and other relatives, to have Mrs. Carney removed as temporary guardian and have the grandmother appointed guardian in place of the aunt. The court appointed Mrs. Carney permanent guardian and the supreme court has now affirmed the appointment.
