

Soil Conservation Scholarships Are Awarded Locally

Mrs. Ludwig Wegner, Radcliffe, and Mrs. James Lamer, Eldora, have been selected as recipients of the Hardin Soil Conservation District scholarships to the Iowa Teachers Conservation Camp, Dean Kelsey, chairman of the district,

has announced.

Two scholarships are awarded annually to teachers actively engaged in teaching in the county. Mrs. Wegner is attending the June 28 to July 18 session and Mrs. Lamer will attend the three week session beginning July 19.

The camp, now in its tenth year of operation, is a regular college course but differs in that a major portion of the instruction is done in the field. Most

of the field instruction is done by guest specialists from various state and federal agencies. These field trips aid the teachers in learning conservation by observing natural resources and seeing the actual conservation practices put into effect.

Modern facilities and recreational opportunities give this summer school a vacation like atmosphere. Fishing, swimming and boating may be enjoyed on the 27 acre lake.
