Gladys Hilleman Donald Funke Are Married Sunday

Miss Gladys M. Hilleman, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Harvey A. Hilleman of State Center, and Donald A. Funke were married at St. Paul's Lutheran church here at 4 o'clock Sunday afternoon by Rev. H. P. Kumpf, the pastor, in the presence of 35 relatives and close friends. The minister used the single ring service as the couple, attended by Mr. and Mrs. Harold Gerke, also of State Center, pledged their nuptial vows before the altar decorated with roses and lighted candles.

(The bridal chorus from "Lohengrin" (Wagner) was played by Mrs. Clarence Meier, and Vernon Braddy sang "Oh Promise Me" (de Koven).

The bride's dress was of powder blue and her arm bouquet was composed of pink roses and white swansonia. Mrs. Gerke wore a dusty rose

street dress.

At 6 o'clock a two-course wedding dinner was served at the home of the bride's parents. A three-tier bridal cake centered the bride's table and the other tables were decorated with lighted candles. A pink and white color scheme was evident in the table service and room decorations.

Mrs. Funke graduated from the State Center high school in 1934 and is employed by the Central Iowa Telephone company as an operator in the local exchange.

Accident claims life of Melbourne woman

At 6:25 p.m. Sunday, Feb. 2, Marshall County Deputies were dispatched to the scene of a personal injury accident involving two cars at the intersection of Hwy. 30 and county blacktop S-62 (also known as Hart Avenue).

Both drivers were transported by ambulance to Marshalltown Medical and Surgical Center. A passenger in one of the vehicles was pronounced dead at the scene.

Preliminary investigation indicated that a car driven by Donald Funke, 111 College

Drive, Melbourne, was south bound on S-62. The Funke vehicle was struck broadside while crossing Hwy. 30, by an east bound vehicle driven by Callie Kabrick of Spencer, IA.

A passenger in the Funke vehicle, Gladys Marie Funke, 80, of Melbourne, was pronounced dead at the scene by Marshall County Medical Examiner Dr. David Bethel.

The collision is still under investigation by the sheriff's office.

Burial will follow in the Rose Hill Memorial Gardens in Marshalltown. Friends may call at the Wensel-Perrin Funeral Home in State Center after 4:00 P.M. on Wednesday evening at the funeral home.

Born October 20, 1916, in State Center, she was the daughter of Harvey and Clara Wengert Hilleman. She received her education in the rural State Center Schools and graduated from the State Center High School in 1934.

On April 14, 1940, she was united in marriage to Donald

Funke at the St. Paul Lutheran Church in State Center areas until retiring to Melbourne in 1979 where they have resided ever since. Mrs. Funke was employed at the Marshall County Care Facility for 12 1/2 years.

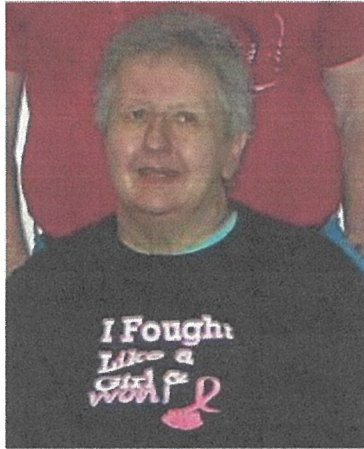

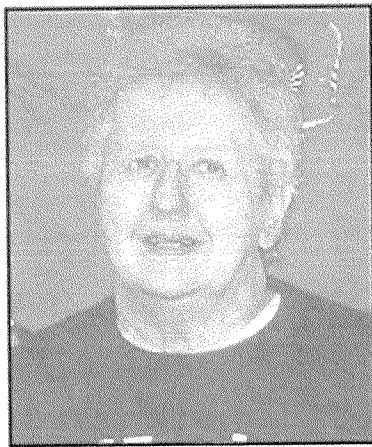
