

Urge Early Entry In SCS Auxiliary Speech Contest

High school juniors and seniors are urged to get their names in early for the speech contest being sponsored by the ladies auxiliary of the Soil Conservation District Commissioners of Iowa.

Anyone interested in entering the contest may contact Mrs. Kenneth Meier at Hubbard. Details for the district contest will then be mailed. Entries are due by April 1.

Rules for the contest are as follows:

Contest open to any boy or girl in junior and senior high school.

Title of the speech to be: "How Soil Conservation Affects my Future".

Speech to be at least five minutes in length and not longer than ten minutes.

Three prizes to be awarded on the district level, \$3, \$2, \$1.

District contest to be held before May 1.

First place winner in the district to advance to the regional contest to be held in the summer. Prize on the regional level

to the winner to be \$10.

First place winner in the regional to advance to the state contest to be held during the state convention of the district commissioners in September.

Anyone who wishes research material to help with his speech may get it in the soil conservation district office in the basement of the postoffice building at Eldora, libraries and science books.
