

Earthwork Finished On 1st Structures In Watershed 7-21-69

Earthwork on the first Big Wyacondah Watershed contract has been completed. This contract included erosion control stabilization structures on the Frank Shively, the Aura Barnett, and the Dale Dixon farms. Recent heavy rains have filled the structure on the Dixon farm and the other two are nearly full.

The work on the first Big Wyacondah Watershed contract was done by Robert McDonnell and Henry Burgher, Bloomfield contractors.

The two structures in the second contract were completed last week. The contractor, J. C. Whisler, Centerville, Iowa, has started to work on the structural waterway on the former Alva Davis farm.

Clay Barnett, chairman of the Davis Soil Conservation District Commissioners, suggests that farmers in the Big Wyacondah Watershed as well as others should see the completed work.

Barnett added that a contract to seed the completed structures would be let the early part of August.

Two more contracts involving 8 or 9 structures will be let later this fall.
