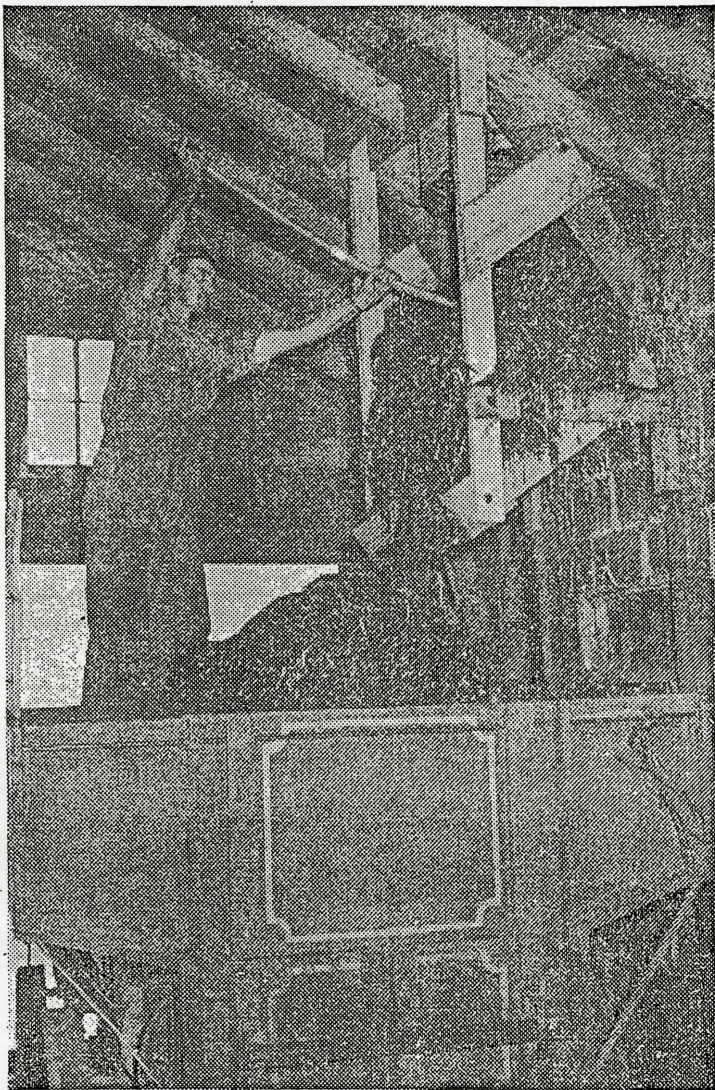


Farm Science Is Practiced—

Silos Next to Barns



Paul Hanlon demonstrates how one of the methods of labor-saving arrangement on Tyden farm No. 6 works out as he pulls sweet clover and molasses silage down into a big wagon in the covered drive which connects the barn and the two silos. This is the same farm as is shown on page 1. In the top picture there you can see the big horses which are pulling this same wagon standing in the entrance to the drive.
