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Iowa Highway Patrolman Mike Scheibler was the guest speaker at Wednesday night's regular meeting of the Davis County Soil Conservation District commissioners.

Scheibler showed a film and gave a short talk on highway safety. "The Unteachables" was the title of the film which portrayed conditions which make a person more likely to have an accident.

The patrolman told the group that highway patrol studies show that people with driver education have only one-half as many accidents as those who do not receive the training.

He also noted that teenagers represent 3 per cent of the licensed drivers, but are responsible for 17 per cent of the accidents.
