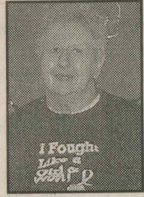

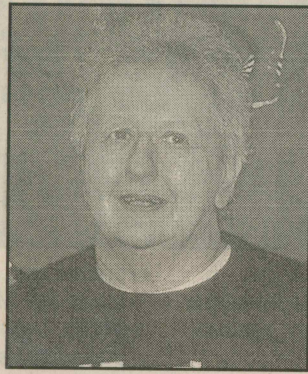

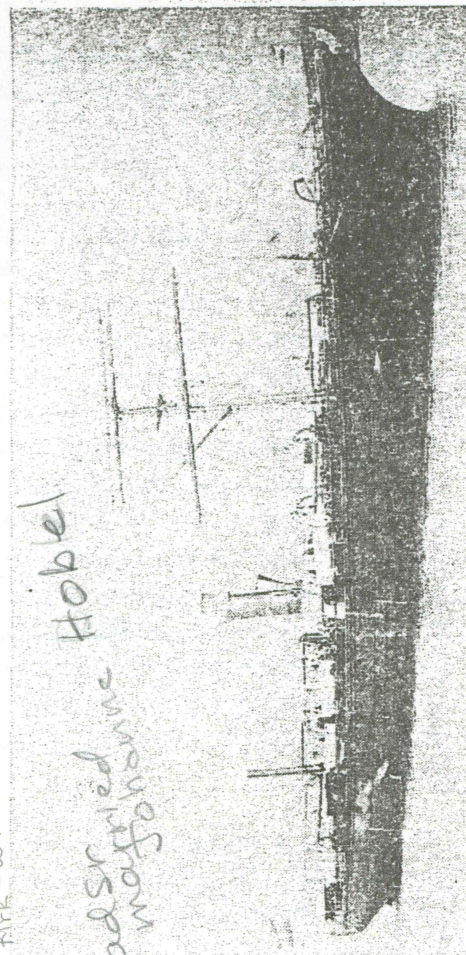

THE AMERICAN DESCENDANTS OF HEINRICK FUNKE
1816 to 1898 **DRAFT 9/4/02**

Heinrick Funke, his wife *Johanne*, three married children including sons *August Sr.* and *Conrad Sr.* and daughter *Johanne Hennis* each with their families left Hamburg Germany on the ship S.S. Donau from Bremen and arrived in New York on March 11, 1881. They traveled with others of the Hennis family which included August's wife, *Karoline*.

The families settled on farms north of State Center, in Marshall County, Iowa as shown on the attached map. As of 2001, several descendants of August Jr. still live on some of the farms that were first settled in 1881. Some of the information of August's descendants was provided by Wayne Funke who with his son Todd, continue to farm near State Center. Over the years, Conrad Funke Sr. and wife *Johanne* had 15 children, including the next to the youngest, *Alvina Marie*. In 1919 *Johanne* and daughter *Hilda* died, and Conrad with several of their younger children moved to LeRoy, Minnesota, near the Iowa border. In later years, Conrad lived with his youngest son, *Clarence*, before Conrad died in 1942 and was buried in the Hillside Cemetery at State Center. The family histories are well described in the attached obituaries for both August Sr., Conrad's brother, who died in 1912, and for Conrad Sr. *Heinrick*, his wife *Johanne* and both sons August Sr. and Conrad Sr. with their wives and other family members are buried in the well kept Hillside Cemetery just north of State Center. See attached photos taken when Alice and Dan Johnson visited State Center in September 2001. Many others of the Funke families are buried at the Rose Hill Memorial Gardens in Marshalltown, Iowa.

Alvina Marie Funke of LeRoy, Minnesota married *Harry Lee Patterson* of Riceville, Iowa in 1929. They lived in Riceville for several years where daughters *Violet*, *Isabelle*, *Alice* and son *LaVerne* were born. The family then moved to Waterloo, Iowa. *Alice* married *Art Landau* in 1950. They had daughters *Diane* and *Debra* and son *Dan Laverne* (deceased). They moved to Long Beach, California 1954. This is where daughter *Dawn* was born.
