

# Big Wyacondah Not Called Off

The Corps of Engineers report labeling a massive flood control program as unfeasible for the Wyacondah River does not alter watershed development plans for Big Wyacondah.

Verle Arnold, work unit conservationist for the Soil Conservation Service here, said Big Wyacondah watershed development—already given the Congressional green light—will

move into the construction stage this fall.

He said the Corps of Engineers report ruling out a federally-financed flood control project on the Wyacondah River has confused some, who came to the conclusion that the watershed project had been canceled. This is not the case.

Initial construction contracts for Big Wyacondah will be let in September according to present plans.

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
