LEGEND: A reinforced concrete drop spillway structure completed in September 1959. The structure is "Island Type" serves as tile outlet for 8" and 12" tiles and as a waterway stabilizer. The waterway was started in the fall of 1959 and completed in the spring of 1960. It was seeded to alfalfa-brome. The waterway drains 615 acres and has a surface flow with grade of 0.50%. Tile drainage outlet provided for 265 acres. Three farmers shared cost. J. C. Costigon of Elkader, Iowa, was the structure contractor.
